## **OFFERINGS - GUILT - SOMETHING MOST HOLY**

Leviticus 7:1" And this is the Law of the guilt offering; It is something most holy.

[11] - References

- And he must bring his guilt offering to Yehowah for his sin that he has committed, namely, a female from the flock, a female lamb or a female kid of the goats, for a sin offering, and the priest must make an atonement for him for his sin. (Leviticus 5:6)
- And as his guilt offering he will bring to Yehowah a sound ram from the flock according to the estimated value, for a guilt offering, to the priest. (Leviticus 6:6)
- And the priest must take the one young ram and offer it for a guilt offering together with the log measure of oil and must wave them to and fro as a wave offering before Yehowah. (Leviticus 14:12)
- And he must bring his guilt offering to Yehowah to the entrance of the tent of meeting, a ram of guilt offering. (Leviticus 19:21)
- And he must live as a Nazirite to Yehowah for the days of his Naziriteship, and he must bring a young ram in its first year as a guilt offering, and the former days will go uncounted because he defiled his Naziriteship. (Numbers 6:12)
- It should not be baked with anything leavened. I have given it as their share out of my offerings made by fire. It is something most holy, like the sin offering and like the guilt offering. (Leviticus 6:17)
- He may eat the bread of his God from the most holy things and from the holy things. (Leviticus 21:22)
- This is the Law concerning the burnt offering, the grain offering and the sin offering and the guilt offering and the installation sacrifice and the communion sacrifice. (Leviticus 7:37)
- This should become yours out of the most holy things, out of the offering made by fire, every offering of theirs together with every grain

offering of theirs and every sin offering of theirs and every guilt offering of theirs, which they will return to me. It is something most holy for you and for your sons. (Numbers 18:9)

- And Kore the son of Imnah the Levite was the gatekeeper to the east, in charge of the voluntary offerings of the true God, to give Yehowah's contribution and the most holy things. (2 Chronicles 31:14)
- And in the porch of the gate there were two tables on this side and two tables on that side, for slaughtering upon them the whole burnt offering and the sin offering and the guilt offering. (Ezekiel 40:39)
