## **OFFERINGS - LAY HANDS UPON THE SACRIFICE**

Sanctuary ··· Offering ··· Lay Hand Upon Offering - Serve as atonement for him· (Leviticus 1:4) [19] - References

Leviticus 1:4... And he must lay his hand upon the head of the burnt offering, and it must be graciously accepted for him to make atonement for him.

[19] - References

- I will also bring them to my holy mountain and make them rejoice inside my house of prayer. Their whole burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be for acceptance upon my altar. For my own house will be called even a house of prayer for all the peoples. (Isaiah 56:7)
- And the priest must make atonement for the whole assembly of the sons of Israel, and it must be forgiven them, because it was a mistake, and they, for their part, brought as their offering an offering made by fire to Yehowah and their sin offering before Yehowah for their mistake. (Numbers 15:25)
- God set him forth as an offering for propitiation through faith in his blood. This was in order to exhibit his own righteousness, because he was forgiving the sins that occurred in the past while God was exercising forbearance. (Romans 3:25)
- And he is a propitiatory sacrifice for our sins, yet not for ours only but also for the whole worlds. (1 John 2:2)
- Then you will take the one ram, and Aaron and his sons must lay their hands upon the ram's head. (Exodus 29:15)
- And he must bring the bull to the entrance of the tent of meeting before Yehowah and must lay his hand upon the bull's head, and he must slaughter the bull before Yehowah. (Leviticus 4:4)
- And the older men of the assembly must lay their hands upon the bull's head before Yehowah, and the bull must be slaughtered before Yehowah. (Leviticus 4:15)

- And he must lay his hand upon the head of the young goat and slaughter it in the place where the burnt offering is regularly slaughtered before Yehowah. It is a sin offering. (Leviticus 4:24)
- And he must lay his hand upon the head of the sin offering and slaughter the sin offering in the same place as the burnt offering. (Leviticus 4:29)
- And he will remove all its fat the same as the fat of the young ram of the communion sacrifice is regularly removed, and the priest must make them smoke on the altar upon Yehowah's offerings made by fire, and the priest must make an atonement for him for his sin that he has committed, and so it must be forgiven him. (Leviticus 4:35)
- And he must bring a sound ram from the flock according to the estimated value, for a guilt offering, to the priest, and the priest must make an atonement for him for his mistake that he committed unintentionally, although he himself did not know it, and so it must be forgiven him. (Leviticus 5:18)
- Then he led up the bull of the sin offering and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the bull of the sin offering. (Leviticus 8:14)
- He now brought the ram of the burnt offering near, and Aaron and his sons then laid their hands upon the head of the ram. (Leviticus 8:18)
- Then at the fulfilling of the days of her purification for a son or for a daughter she will bring a young ram in its first year for a burnt offering and a young pigeon or a turtledove for a sin offering to the entrance of the tent of meeting to the priest. (Leviticus 12:6)
- And Aaron must lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat and confess over it all the errors of the sons of Israel and all their revolts in all their sins, and he must put them upon the head of the goat and send it away by the hand of a ready man into the wilderness. (Leviticus 16:21)
- And you must present the Levites before Yehowah, and the sons of Israel must lay their hands upon the Levites. (Numbers 8:10)
- Then the Levites will lay their hands upon the heads of the bulls. After that, render up the one as a sin offering and the other as a burnt offering to Yehowah to make atonement for the Levites. (Numbers 8:12)

- And David went on to say to the Gibeonites; What shall I do to YOU, and with what shall I make atonement, that YOU may certainly bless the inheritance of Yehowah? (2 Samuel 21:3)
- Then they brought the male goats of the sin offering near before the king and the congregation and laid their hands upon them. (2 Chronicles 29:23)
