OFFERINGS - LEPROSY - SLAUGHTER THE YOUNG RAM

~ Sanctuary ··· Offering ··· Leprosy - Slaughter the young ram where the sin and burnt offerings are slaughtered, because the offering belongs to the priest, it is something most holy (Leviticus 14:13) [13] - References

Leviticus 14:13... And he must slaughter the young ram in the place where the sin offering and the burnt offering are regularly slaughtered, in a holy place, because, like the sin offering, the guilt offering belongs to the priest. It is something most holy.

[13] - References

- And you must place them all upon the palms of Aaron and upon the palms of his sons, and you must wave them to and fro as a wave offering before Yehowah. (Exodus 29:24)
- His hands will bring as Yehowah's offerings made by fire the fat upon the breast. He will bring it with the breast to wave it to and fro as a wave offering before Yehowah. (Leviticus 7:30)
- And Aaron must cause the Levites to move to and fro before Yehowah as a wave offering from the sons of Israel, and they must serve for carrying on the service of Yehowah. (Numbers 8:11)
- And it must be slaughtered at the side of the altar to the north before Yehowah, and the sons of Aaron, the priests, must sprinkle its blood round about upon the altar. (Leviticus 1:11)
- And he must bring the bull to the entrance of the tent of meeting before Yehowah and must lay his hand upon the bull's head, and he must slaughter the bull before Yehowah. (Leviticus 4:4)
- Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying; This is the Law of the sin offering; In the place where the burnt offering is regularly slaughtered the sin offering will be slaughtered before Yehowah. It is a most holy thing. (Leviticus 6:25)
- Every male among the priests will eat it. In a holy place it will be eaten. It is something most holy. (Leviticus 7:6)

- And what is left of the grain offering belongs to Aaron and his sons, as something most holy from Yehowah's offerings made by fire. (Leviticus 2:3)
- Like the sin offering, so is the guilt offering. There is one Law for them. The priest who will make atonement with it, his it will become. (Leviticus 7:7)
- Do you not know that the men performing sacred duties eat the things of the temple, and those constantly attending at the altar have a portion for themselves with the altar? (1 Corinthians 9:13)
- LOOK at that which is Israel in a fleshly way; Are not those who eat the sacrifices sharers with the altar? (1 Corinthians 10:18)
- And he must lay his hand upon its head, and it must be slaughtered before the tent of meeting, and Aaron's sons must sprinkle its blood round about upon the altar. (Leviticus 3:13)
- In a most holy place you should eat it. Every male should eat it. It should become something holy to you. (Numbers 18:10)
