OFFERINGS - NO HONEY OR LEAVEN

Sanctuary ··· Offering ··· No Honey Or Leaven - No grain offering should be presented leavened, No honey or sourdough must smoke as an offering made to Yehowah · (Leviticus 2:11) [11] - References

Leviticus 2:11" No grain offering that you will present to Yehowah should be made a leavened thing, because you must make no sourdough and no honey at all smoke as an offering made by fire to Yehowah.

[11] - References

- Seven days no sourdough is to be found in YOUR houses, because anyone tasting what is leavened, whether he is an alien resident or a native of the land, that soul must be cut off from the assembly of Israel. (Exodus 12:19)
- It should not be baked with anything leavened. I have given it as their share out of my offerings made by fire. It is something most holy, like the sin offering and like the guilt offering. (Leviticus 6:17)
- Then they grasped that he said to watch out, not for the leaven of the loaves, but for the teaching of the Pharisees and Sadducees. (Matthew 16:12)
- Clear away the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, according as you are free from ferment. For, indeed, Christ our Passover has been sacrificed. (1 Corinthians 5:7)
- A little leaven ferments the whole lump. (Galatians 5:9)
- Along with ring-shaped cakes of leavened bread he will present his offering together with the thanksgiving sacrifice of his communion sacrifices. (Leviticus 7:13)
- He next presented the grain offering and filled his hand with some of it and made it smoke upon the altar, apart from the burnt offering of the morning. (Leviticus 9:17)
- These are the seasonal festivals of Yehowah that you should proclaim as holy conventions, for presenting an offering made by fire to Yehowah, the burnt offering and the grain offering of the sacrifice

and the drink offerings according to the daily schedule. (Leviticus 23:37)

- The one presenting his offering must also present to Yehowah a grain offering of fine flour, a tenth of an ephah, moistened with a fourth of a hin of oil. (Numbers 15:4)
- And three tenth measures of fine flour as a grain offering moistened with oil for each bull and two tenth measures of fine flour as a grain offering moistened with oil for the one ram. (Numbers 28:12)
- How is it You do not discern that I did not talk to You about loaves? But watch out for the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees. (Matthew 16:11)
