OFFERINGS - SEASONAL FESTIVALS - RENDER UP AT YOUR SEASONAL

Numbers 29:39. These you will render up to Yehowah at your seasonal festivals, besides your vow offerings and your voluntary offerings as your burnt offerings and your grain offerings and your drink offerings and your communion sacrifices.

[16] - References

- Speak to the sons of Israel, and you must say to them; The seasonal festivals of Yehowah that you should proclaim are holy conventions. These are my seasonal festivals. (Leviticus 23:2)
- Three times in the year every male of yours should appear before Yehowah your God in the place that he will choose, in the festival of the unfermented cakes and in the festival of weeks and in the festival of booths, and none should appear before Yehowah empty-handed. (Deuteronomy 16:16)
- And you must render up an offering made by fire to Yehowah, a burnt offering or a sacrifice to perform a special vow or voluntarily or during your seasonal festivals, in order to make a restful odor to Yehowah, from the herd or from the flock. (Numbers 15:3)
- And there you must bring your burnt offerings and your sacrifices and your tenth parts and the contribution of your hand and your vow offerings and your voluntary offerings and the firstborn ones of your herd and of your flock. (Deuteronomy 12:6)
- And if the sacrifice of his offering is a vow or a voluntary offering, it is to be eaten on the day of his presenting his sacrifice, and on the next day what is left of it also may be eaten. (Leviticus 7:16)
- And in case a man should present a communion sacrifice to Yehowah in order to pay a vow or as a voluntary offering, it should prove to be a sound one among the herd or the flock, in order to gain approval. No defect at all should prove to be in it. (Leviticus 22:21)

- If his offering is a burnt offering from the herd, a male, a sound one, is what he should present. At the entrance of the tent of meeting he should present it of his own free will before Yehowah. (Leviticus 1:3)
- Now in case some soul would present as an offering a grain offering to Yehowah, his offering should prove to be fine flour, and he must pour oil over it and put frankincense upon it. (Leviticus 2:1)
- And you should render up wine as a drink offering, the fourth of a hin, together with the burnt offering or for the sacrifice of each male lamb. (Numbers 15:5)
- And if his offering is a communion sacrifice, if he is presenting it from the herd, whether a male or a female, a sound one is what he will present before Yehowah. (Leviticus 3:1)
- Besides the Sabbaths of Yehowah and besides YOUR gifts and besides all YOUR vow offerings and besides all YOUR voluntary offerings, which YOU should give to Yehowah. (Leviticus 23:38)
- And in the day of Your rejoicing and in Your festal seasons and at the commencements of Your months, You must blow on the trumpets over Your burnt offerings and Your communion sacrifices, and their use must serve as a memorial for You before Your God. I am Yehowah Your God. (Numbers 10:10)
- And Kore the son of Imnah the Levite was the gatekeeper to the east, in charge of the voluntary offerings of the true God, to give Yehowah's contribution and the most holy things. (2 Chronicles 31:14)
- And afterward there was the constant burnt offering and that for the new moons and for all the sanctified festival seasons of Yehowah and for everyone that willingly offered a voluntary offering to Yehowah. (Ezra 3:5)
- Please take pleasure in the voluntary offerings of my mouth, O Yehowah, and teach me your own judicial decisions. (Psalms 119:108)
- Of what benefit to me is the multitude of YOUR sacrifices, says Yehowah? I have had enough of whole burnt offerings of rams and the fat of well-fed animals, and in the blood of young bulls and male lambs and he-goats I have taken no delight. (Isaiah 1:11)
