Leviticus 9:15... He now went presenting the offering of the people and took the goat of the sin offering that was for the people and slaughtered it and made an offering for sin with it as with the first.

[14] - References

- And if any soul of the people of the land sins unintentionally by his doing one of the things that Yehowah commands should not be done and he does become guilty. (Leviticus 4:27)
- But Yehowah himself took delight in crushing him, he made him sick. If you will set his soul as a guilt offering, he will see his offspring, he will prolong his days, and in his hand what is the delight of Yehowah will succeed. (Isaiah 53:10)
- The next day he beheld Jesus coming toward him, and he said; See, the Lamb of God that takes away the sin of the world! (John 1:29)
- For I handed on to you, among the first things, that which I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures. (1 Corinthians 15:3)
- The one who did not know sin he made to be sin for us, that we might become God's righteousness by means of him. (2 Corinthians 5:21)
- He gave himself for our sins that he might deliver us from the present wicked system of things according to the will of our God and Father. (Galatians 1:4)
- And go on walking in love, just as the Christ also loved You and delivered himself up for You as an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling odor. (Ephesians 5:2)
- Who gave himself for us that he might deliver us from every sort of Lawlessness and cleanse for himself a people peculiarly his own, zealous for fine works. (Titus 2:14)

- consequently he was obliged to become like his brothers in all respects, that he might become a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, in order to offer propitiatory sacrifice for the sins of the people. (Hebrews 2:17)
- He himself bore our sins in his own body upon the stake, in order, that we might be done with sins and live to righteousness. And by his stripes you were healed. (1 Peter 2:24)
- And he is a propitiatory sacrifice for our sins, yet not for ours only but also for the whole worlds. (1 John 2:2)
- And Moses searched thoroughly for the goat of the sin offering, and, look! It had been burned up. So he grew indignant at Eleazar and Ithamar, Aaron's sons that were left, saying; (Leviticus 10:16)
- Then they brought the male goats of the sin offering near before the king and the congregation and laid their hands upon them. (2 Chronicles 29:23)
- He does not need daily, as those High Priests do, to offer up sacrifices, first for his own sins and then for those of the people, for this he did once for all time when he offered himself up. (Hebrews 7:27)
