## **OFFERINGS - VOW OR VOLUNTARY OFFERINGS**

Leviticus 22:18" Speak to Aaron and his sons and all the sons of Israel, and you must say to them; As for any man of the house of Israel or some alien resident in Israel who presents his offering, for any of their vows or for any of their voluntary offerings, which they may present to Yehowah for a burnt offering.

[12] - References

- And in case there should be residing as an alien with you an alien resident or one who is in your midst for generations of you, and he must render up an offering made by fire, of a restful odor to Yehowah, just as you should do, so he should do. (Numbers 15:14)
- There should prove to be one Law and one judicial decision for you and for the alien resident who is residing as an alien with you. (Numbers 15:16)
- And if the sacrifice of his offering is a vow or a voluntary offering, it is to be eaten on the day of his presenting his sacrifice, and on the next day what is left of it also may be eaten. (Leviticus 7:16)
- Besides the Sabbaths of Yehowah and besides YOUR gifts and besides all YOUR vow offerings and besides all YOUR voluntary offerings, which YOU should give to Yehowah. (Leviticus 23:38)
- And you must render up an offering made by fire to Yehowah, a burnt offering or a sacrifice to perform a special vow or voluntarily or during your seasonal festivals, in order to make a restful odor to Yehowah, from the herd or from the flock. (Numbers 15:3)
- From you my praise will be in the large congregation, my vows I shall pay in front of those fearing him. (Psalms 22:25)
- Upon me, O God, there are vows to you. I shall render expressions of thanksqiving to you. (Psalms 56:12)
- And there you must bring your burnt offerings and your sacrifices and your tenth parts and the contribution of your hand and your vow

offerings and your voluntary offerings and the firstborn ones of your herd and of your flock. (Deuteronomy 12:6)

- Speak to the sons of Israel, and you must say to them; In case some man of you would present an offering to Yehowah from the domestic animals, you should present your offering from the herd and from the flock. (Leviticus 1:2)
- And it must occur that the place that Yehowah YOUR God will choose to have his name reside there is where YOU will bring all about which I am commanding YOU, YOUR burnt offerings and YOUR sacrifices, YOUR tenth parts and the contribution of YOUR hand and every choice of YOUR YOW offerings that YOU will yow to Yehowah. (Deuteronomy 12:11)
- Surely your holy things that will become yours, and your vow offerings you should carry, and you must come to the place that Yehowah will choose. (Deuteronomy 12:26)
- And from what is leavened make a thanksgiving sacrifice to smoke, and proclaim voluntary offerings, publish it, for that is the way you have loved, O sons of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Amos 4:5)
