

OFFERINGS - YOUNG BULL - MUST BE SLAUGHTERED BEFORE

~ **Sanctuary** ... **Offering** ... **Young bull** - Must be slaughtered before Yehowah, present the blood and sprinkle round about the altar

Leviticus 1:5 Then the young bull must be slaughtered before Yehowah, and the sons of Aaron, the priests, must present the blood and sprinkle the blood round about upon the altar, which is at the entrance of the tent of meeting.

- Also, every priest takes his station from day to day to render public service and to offer the same sacrifices often, as these are at no time able to take sins away completely. (**Hebrews 10:11**)
- For if the **blood** of goats and of **bulls** and the ashes of a heifer sprinkled on those who have been defiled sanctifies to the extent of cleanness of the flesh. (**Hebrews 9:13**)
- According to the foreknowledge of God the Father, with sanctification by the spirit, for the purpose of their being obedient and sprinkled with the **blood** of Jesus Christ; May undeserved kindness and peace be increased to **you**. (**1 Peter 1:2**)
- And you **must** slaughter the **bull** before Yehowah, at the **entrance** of the **tent** of **meeting**. (**Exodus 29:11**)
- And he **must** spatter some of the **blood** of the sin offering upon the side of the **altar**, but the remainder of the **blood** will be drained out at the base of the **altar**. It is a sin offering. (**Leviticus 5:9**)
- In the place where they regularly slaughter the burnt offering they will slaughter the guilt offering, and its **blood** one will **sprinkle round about** upon the **altar**. (**Leviticus 7:2**)
- Then he **slaughtered** the burnt offering and Aaron's **sons** handed him the **blood** and he sprinkled it **round about** upon the **altar**. (**Leviticus 9:12**)
- Accordingly they **slaughtered** the cattle and the **priests** received the **blood** and sprinkled it upon the **altar**, after which they **slaughtered**

the rams and sprinkled the **blood** upon the **altar**, and they **slaughtered** the male lambs and sprinkled the **blood** upon the **altar**. (2 Chronicles 29:22)

- And they kept standing at their place according to their rule, according to the Law of Moses the man of the true God, the **priests** sprinkling the **blood** received from the hand of the Levites. (2 Chronicles 30:16)

- And they proceeded to slaughter the Passover victim and the **priests** sprinkled the **blood** from their hand, while the Levites were stripping the skins off. (2 Chronicles 35:11)

- And what is needed, young **bulls** as well as rams and lambs for the burnt offerings to the God of heaven, wheat, salt, wine and oil, just as the **priests** that are in Jerusalem say, let there be given them continually day by day without fail. (Ezra 6:9)

- Accordingly you will promptly buy with this money **bulls**, rams, lambs and their grain offerings and their drink offerings and you will **present** them upon the **altar** of the house of **YOUR** God, which is in Jerusalem. (Ezra 7:17)

- Those coming out of the captivity, the former exiles, themselves presented burnt sacrifices to the God of Israel, twelve **bulls** for all Israel, ninety-six rams, seventy-seven male lambs, twelve he-goats as a sin offering, everything as a burnt offering to **Yehowah**. (Ezra 8:35)

- And he proceeded to say to me; Son of man, this is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has said; These are the statutes of the **altar** on the day of its being made, in order to offer upon it whole burnt offerings and to **sprinkle** upon it blood. (Ezekiel 43:18)
