Witness ... Paul ... Agrippa - That the Christ was to suffer and as the first to be resurrected from the dead he would publish light both to this people and to the nations (Acts of Apostles 26:23) [13] - References

Acts of Apostles 26:23... That the Christ was to suffer and, as the first to be resurrected from the dead, he was going to publish light both to this people and to the nations.

- As for all those seeing me, they hold me in derision, they keep opening their mouths wide, they keep wagging their head. (Psalms 22:7)
- For dogs have surrounded me, the assembly of evildoers themselves have enclosed me. Like a lion they are at my hands and my feet. (Psalms 22:16)
- O may those who for no reason are my enemies not rejoice over me, as for those hating me without cause, let them not wink the eye. (Psalms 35:19)
- My back I gave to the strikers, and my cheeks to those plucking off the hair. My face I did not conceal from humiliating things and spit. (Isaiah 50:6)
- But he was being pierced for our transgression, he was being crushed for our errors. The chastisement meant for our peace was upon him, and because of his wounds there has been a healing for us. (Isaiah 53:5)
- For you will not leave my soul in Sheol. You will not allow your loyal one to see the pit. (Psalms 16:10)
- A light for removing the veil from the nations and a glory of your people Israel. (Luke 2:32)
- That is why I shall laud you among the nations, O Yehowah, and to your name I will make melody. (Psalms 18:49)
- And it must occur in that day that there will be the root of Jesse that will be standing up as a signal for the peoples. To him even the

nations will turn inquiringly, and his resting-place must become glorious. (Isaiah 11:10)

- He will likewise startle many nations. At him kings will shut their mouth, because what had not been recounted to them they will actually see, and to what they had not heard they must turn their consideration. (Isaiah 52:15)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; CRY out loudly to Jacob with rejoicing, and CRY shrilly at the head of nations. Publish it. GIVE praise and SAY; Save, O Yehowah, your people, the remnant of Israel. (Jeremiah 31:7)
- However, now Christ has been raised up from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep in death. (1 Corinthians 15:20)
- And when I saw him, I fell as dead at his feet. And he laid his right hand upon me and said; Do not be fearful. I am the First and the Last. (Revelation 1:17)
