**Acts of Apostles 20:24**· Nevertheless, I do not make my soul of any account as dear to me, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received of the Lord Jesus, to bear thorough witness to the Good News of the undeserved kindness of God.

- Who will separate us from the love of the Christ? Will tribulation or distress or persecution or hunger or nakedness or danger or sword? (**Romans 8:35**)
- Therefore we do not give up, but even if the man we are outside is wasting away, certainly the man we are inside is being renewed from day to day. (**2 Corinthians 4:16**)
- I have fought the fine fight, I have run the **course** to the **finish**, I have observed the faith. (**2 Timothy 4:7**)
- That is why, since we have this **ministry** according to the mercy that was shown us, we do not give up. (**2 Corinthians 4:1**)
- But all things are from **God**, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the **ministry** of the reconciliation. (**2 Corinthians 5:18**)
- Paul, an apostle, neither from men nor through a man, but through **Jesus** Christ and **God** the Father, who raised him up from the dead. (**Galatians 1:1**)
- Working together with him, we also entreat **you** not to accept the **undeserved kindness** of **God** and miss its purpose. (**2 Corinthians 6:1**)
- And he proceeded to put his **soul** in his palm and strike the Philistine down, so that Yehowah performed a great salvation for all Israel. You saw it, and you gave way to rejoicing. So why should you

sin against innocent blood in having David put to death for nothing? (**1 Samuel 19:5**)

- For whoever wants to save his **soul** will lose it, but whoever loses his **soul** for my sake is the one that will save it. (**Luke 9:24**)

- Moreover, I say to **you**, my friends; Do not fear those who kill the body and after this are not able to do anything more. (**Luke 12:4**)

- Then Paul answered; What are **you** doing by weeping and making me weak at heart? Rest assured, I am ready not **only** to be bound but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the **Lord Jesus**. (**Acts of Apostles 21:13**)

- For me to be a public servant of Christ **Jesus** to the nations, engaging in the holy work of the **Good News** of **God**, in order, that the offering, namely, these nations, might prove to be acceptable, it being sanctified with Holy Spirit. (**Romans 15:16**)

- And with supplication for **you** they long for **you** because of the surpassing **undeserved kindness** of **God** upon **you**. (**2 Corinthians 9:14**)

- Because on **account** of the Lord's work he came quite near to death, exposing his **soul** to danger, that he might fully make up for **YOUR** not being here to render private service to me. (**Philippians 2:30**)

- And they conquered him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their witnessing, and they did not love their **souls** even in the face of death. (**Revelation 12:11**)
