- For them to seek God, if they might grope for him and really find him, although, in fact, he is not far off from each one of us. **(Acts of Apostles 17:27)**
- For his invisible qualities are clearly seen from the world's creation onward, because they are perceived by the things made, even his eternal power and Godship, so that they are inexcusable. **(Romans 1:20)**
- There is a drenching of its furrows, a leveling off of its clods, with copious showers you soften it, you bless its very sprouts. **(Psalms 65:10)**
- The One who is covering the **heavens** with clouds, the One preparing rain for the earth, the One making the mountains to sprout green grass. **(Psalms 147:8)**
- But they have not said in their heart; Let us, now, fear Yehowah our God, the One who is **giving** the downpour and the autumn rain and the spring rain in its season, the One who guards even the prescribed weeks of the harvest for us. **(Jeremiah 5:24)**
- That **YOU** may prove yourselves sons of **YOUR** Father who is in the **heavens**, since he makes his sun rise upon wicked people and **good** and makes it rain upon righteous people and unrighteous. **(Matthew 5:45)**
- You are opening your hand and satisfying the desire of every living thing. **(Psalms 145:16)**

- And God went on to say; Here I have given to **you** all vegetation bearing seed which is on the surface of the whole earth and every tree on which there is the fruit of a tree bearing seed. To **you** let it serve as **food**. (**Genesis 1:29**)
- To the One **giving** rain upon the surface of the earth and sending waters upon the open fields. (**Job 5:10**)
- Yet he himself has filled their houses with **good** things, and the very counsel of wicked ones has kept far from me. (**Job 22:18**)
- For by them he pleads the cause of peoples, he gives **food** in abundance. (**Job 36:31**)
- What is mortal man that you keep him in mind, and the son of earthling man that you take care of him? (**Psalms 8:4**)
- Good and upright is Yehowah. That is why he instructs sinners in the way. (**Psalms 25:8**)
- He is a lover of righteousness and justice. With the loving-kindness of Yehowah the earth is filled. (**Psalms 33:5**)
- You have turned your attention to the earth, that you may give it abundance, you enrich it very much. The stream from God is **full** of water. You prepare their grain, for that is the way you prepare the earth. (**Psalms 65:9**)
- The pastures have become clothed with flocks, and the low plains themselves are enveloped with grain. They shout in triumph, yes, they sing. (**Psalms 65:13**)
- He is watering the mountains from his upper chambers. With the fruitage of your works the earth is satisfied. (**Psalms 104:13**)
- And they sow fields and plant vineyards, that they may yield **fruitful** crops. (**Psalms 107:37**)
- Yehowah is **good** to all, and his mercies are over all his works. (**Psalms 145:9**)
- With a man there is nothing better than that he should eat and indeed drink and cause his soul to see **good** because of his hard work. This too I have seen, even I, that this is from the hand of the true God. (**Ecclesiastes 2:24**)
- All are the same in what all have. One eventuality there is to the righteous one and the wicked one, the **good** one and the clean one and the unclean one, and the one sacrificing and the one that is not

sacrificing. The **good** one is the same as the sinner, the one swearing is the same as whoever has been afraid of a sworn oath. (**Ecclesiastes 9:2**)

- Go, eat your **food** with rejoicing and drink your wine with a **good** heart, because already the true God has found pleasure in your works. (**Ecclesiastes 9:7**)
