- For you will not leave my soul in Sheol. You will not allow your loyal one to see the pit. (**Psalms 16:10**)
- Whereas **you** killed the Chief Agent of life. But God raised him up from the dead, of which fact we are witnesses. (**Acts of Apostles 3:15**)
- But also for the sake of us to whom it is destined to be counted, because we believe on him who raised Jesus our Lord up from the dead. (**Romans 4:24**)
- But God both raised up the Lord and will raise us up out of **death** through his power. (**1 Corinthians 6:14**)
- For **you** were buried with him in his baptism, and by relationship with him **you** were also raised up together through **your** faith in the operation of God, who raised him up from the dead. (**Colossians 2:12**)
- Now may the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great shepherd of the sheep with the blood of an everlasting covenant, our Lord Jesus. (**Hebrews 13:20**)
- Show me favor, O Yehowah, see my affliction by those hating me, O you who are lifting me up from the gates of **death**. (**Psalms 9:13**)
- No man has taken it away from me, but I surrender it of my own initiative. I have authority to surrender it, and I have authority to receive it again. The commandment on this I received from my Father. (**John 10:18**)
- Let it be known to all of **you** and to all the people of Israel, that in the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, whom **you** impaled but whom

God raised up from the dead, by this one does this man stand here sound in front of **you**. (**Acts of Apostles 4:10**)

- The God of our forefathers raised up Jesus, whom **you** slew, hanging him upon a stake. (**Acts of Apostles 5:30**)
- God raised this One up on the third day and granted him to become manifest. (**Acts of Apostles 10:40**)
- But God raised him up from the dead. (**Acts of Apostles 13:30**)
- Because he has set a day in which he purposes to judge the inhabited earth in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed, and he has furnished a guarantee to all men in that he has **resurrected** him from the dead. (**Acts of Apostles 17:31**)
- If, now, the spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in **you**, he that raised up Christ Jesus from the dead will also make **your** mortal bodies alive through his spirit that resides in **you**. (**Romans 8:11**)
- Moreover, we are also found false witnesses of God, because we have borne witness against God that he raised up the Christ, but whom he did not raise up if the dead are really not to be raised up. (**1 Corinthians 15:15**)
- Paul, an apostle, neither from men nor through a man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised him up from the dead. (**Galatians 1:1**)
- With which he has operated in the case of the Christ when he raised him up from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places. (**Ephesians 1:20**)
- And to wait for his Son from the heavens, whom he raised up from the dead, namely, Jesus, who delivers us from the wrath which is coming. (**1 Thessalonians 1:10**)
- Remember that Jesus Christ was raised up from the dead and was of David's seed, according to the Good News I preach. (**2 Timothy 2:8**)
- Who through him are believers in God, the one who raised him up from the dead and gave him glory, so that **your** faith and hope might be in God. (**1 Peter 1:21**)
