Acts of Apostles 3:19· Repent, therefore, and turn around so as to get **YOUR** sins blotted out, that seasons of refreshing may come from the person of Yehowah.

- Peter said to them; Repent, and let each one of **YOU** be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for forgiveness of **YOUR sins**, and **YOU** will receive the free gift of the Holy Spirit. **(Acts of Apostles 2:38)**
- Say to them; As I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**, I take delight, not in the death of the wicked one, but in that someone wicked **turns** back from his way and actually keeps living. Turn back, **turn** back from **YOUR** bad ways, for why is it that **YOU** should die, O house of Israel? **(Ezekiel 33:11)**
- That **YOU** should put away the old personality which conforms to **YOUR** former course of conduct and which is being corrupted according to his deceptive desires. **(Ephesians 4:22)**
- For the time that has passed by is sufficient for **YOU** to have worked **out** the will of the nations when **YOU** proceeded in deeds of loose conduct, lusts, excesses with wine, revelries, drinking matches, and illegal idolatries. **(1 Peter 4:3)**
- None of his **sins** with which he has sinned will be remembered against him. Justice and righteousness are what he has carried on. He will positively keep living. **(Ezekiel 33:16)**
- However, if we are walking in the light as he himself is in the light, we do have a sharing with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. **(1 John 1:7)**
- Those to whom he has said; This is the resting-place. **GIVE** rest to the weary one. And this is the place of ease, but who were not willing to hear. **(Isaiah 28:12)**

- And the priest must write these cursings in the book and must wipe them **out** into the bitter water. (**Numbers 5:23**)
- For you will listen to the voice of **Yehowah** your God so as to keep his commandments and his statutes written in this book of the Law, because you will return to **Yehowah** your God with all your heart and all your soul. (**Deuteronomy 30:10**)
- You will conceal them in the secret place of your **person** from the banding together of men. You will hide them in your booth from the quarreling of tongues. (**Psalms 31:20**)
- Happy is the one whose revolt is pardoned, whose sin is covered. (**Psalms 32:1**)
- I will teach transgressors your ways, that sinners themselves may **turn** right back to you. (**Psalms 51:13**)
- By loving-kindness and trueness error is atoned for, and in the fear of **Yehowah** one **turns** away from bad. (**Proverbs 16:6**)
- Return, **you** people, to the One against whom the sons of Israel have gone deep in their revolt. (**Isaiah 31:6**)
- Let the wicked man leave his way, and the harmful man his thoughts, and let him return to **Yehowah**, who will have mercy upon him, and to our God, for he will forgive in a large way. (**Isaiah 55:7**)
- Therefore say to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has said; Come back and **turn** yourselves back from **YOUR** dungy idols and **turn YOUR** faces back even from all **YOUR** detestable things. (**Ezekiel 14:6**)
- Now as regards someone wicked, in case he should **turn** back from all his **sins** that he has committed and he should actually keep all my statutes and execute justice and righteousness, he will positively keep living. He will not die. (**Ezekiel 18:21**)
- And when I say to the wicked one; You will positively die, and he actually **turns** back from his sin and carries on justice and righteousness. (**Ezekiel 33:14**)
- And let them cover themselves with sackcloth, man and domestic animal, and let them call **out** to God with strength and **come** back, each one from his bad way and from the violence that was in their hands. (**Jonah 3:8**)

- And I will pour **out** upon the house of David and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the spirit of favor and entreaties, and they will certainly look to the One whom they pierced through, and they will certainly wail over Him as in the wailing over an only son, and there will be a bitter lamentation over him as when there is bitter lamentation over the firstborn son. (**Zechariah 12:10**)
- So they set **out** and preached in order, that people might repent. (**Mark 6:12**)
- No, indeed, I tell **you**, but, unless **you** repent, **you** will all likewise be destroyed. (**Luke 13:3**)
- And **blotted out** the handwritten document against us, which consisted of decrees and which was in opposition to us, and He has taken it **out** of the way by nailing it to the torture stake. (**Colossians 2:14**)
- Therefore repent. If you do not, I am coming to you quickly, and I will war with them with the long sword of my mouth. (**Revelation 2:16**)
