WITNESSES - PETER - REPENT THEREFORE AND TURN AROUND

Witness ... Peter ... Repent therefore and turn around so as to get your sins blotted out that seasons of refreshing may come from the person of Yehowah. (Acts of Apostles 3:19) [24] - References

Acts of Apostles 3:19... Repent, therefore, and turn around so as to get YOUR sins blotted out, that seasons of refreshing may come from the person of Yehowah.

[24] - References

- Peter said to them; Repent, and let each one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the free gift of the Holy Spirit. (Acts of Apostles 2:38)
- Say to them; As I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, I take delight, not in the death of the wicked one, but in that someone wicked turns back from his way and actually keeps living. Turn back, turn back from YOUR bad ways, for why is it that YOU should die, O house of Israel? (Ezekiel 33:11)
- That you should put away the old personality which conforms to your former course of conduct and which is being corrupted according to his deceptive desires. (Ephesians 4:22)
- For the time that has passed by is sufficient for you to have worked out the will of the nations when you proceeded in deeds of loose conduct, lusts, excesses with wine, revelries, drinking matches, and illegal idolatries. (1 Peter 4:3)
- None of his sins with which he has sinned will be remembered against him. Justice and righteousness are what he has carried on. He will positively keep living. (Ezekiel 33:16)
- However, if we are walking in the light as he himself is in the light, we do have a sharing with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. (1 John 1:7)
- Those to whom he has said; This is the resting-place. GIVE rest to the weary one. And this is the place of ease, but who were not willing to hear. (Isaiah 28:12)

- And the priest must write these cursings in the book and must wipe them out into the bitter water. (Numbers 5:23)
- For you will listen to the voice of Yehowah your God so as to keep his commandments and his statutes written in this book of the Law, because you will return to Yehowah your God with all your heart and all your soul. (Deuteronomy 30:10)
- You will conceal them in the secret place of your person from the banding together of men. You will hide them in your booth from the guarreling of tongues. (Psalms 31:20)
- Happy is the one whose revolt is pardoned, whose sin is covered. (Psalms 32:1)
- I will teach transgressors your ways, that sinners themselves may turn right back to you. (Psalms 51:13)
- By loving-kindness and trueness error is atoned for, and in the fear of Yehowah one turns away from bad. (Proverbs 16:6)
- Return, YOU people, to the One against whom the sons of Israel have gone deep in their revolt. (Isaiah 31:6)
- Let the wicked man leave his way, and the harmful man his thoughts, and let him return to Yehowah, who will have mercy upon him, and to our God, for he will forgive in a large way. (Isaiah 55:7)
- Therefore say to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Come back and turn yourselves back from YOUR dungy idols and turn YOUR faces back even from all YOUR detestable things. (Ezekiel 14:6)
- Now as regards someone wicked, in case he should turn back from all his sins that he has committed and he should actually keep all my statutes and execute justice and righteousness, he will positively keep living. He will not die. (Ezekiel 18:21)
- And when I say to the wicked one; You will positively die, and he actually turns back from his sin and carries on justice and righteousness. (Ezekiel 33:14)
- And let them cover themselves with sackcloth, man and domestic animal, and let them call out to God with strength and come back, each one from his bad way and from the violence that was in their hands. (Jonah 3:8)

- And I will pour out upon the house of David and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the spirit of favor and entreaties, and they will certainly look to the One whom they pierced through, and they will certainly wail over Him as in the wailing over an only son, and there will be a bitter lamentation over him as when there is bitter lamentation over the firstborn son. (Zechariah 12:10)
- So they set out and preached in order, that people might repent. (Mark 6:12)
- No, indeed, I tell you, but, unless you repent, you will all likewise be destroyed. (Luke 13:3)
- And blotted out the handwritten document against us, which consisted of decrees and which was in opposition to us, and He has taken it out of the way by nailing it to the torture stake. (Colossians 2:14)
- Therefore repent. If you do not, I am coming to you quickly, and I will war with them with the long sword of my mouth. (Revelation 2:16)
