Acts of Apostles 5:30... The God of our forefathers raised up Jesus, whom **YOU** slew, hanging him upon a stake.

- But God resurrected him by loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to continue to be held fast by it. (**Acts of Apostles 2:24**)
- But God **raised** him up from the dead. (**Acts of Apostles 13:30**)
- This man, as one delivered up by the determined counsel and foreknowledge of God, **you** fastened to a **stake** by the hand of Lawless men and did away with. (**Acts of Apostles 2:23**)
- And we are witnesses of all the things he did both in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem, but they also did away with him by **hanging** him on a **stake**. (**Acts of Apostles 10:39**)
- Christ by purchase released us from the curse of the Law by becoming a curse instead of us, because it is written; Accursed is every man hanged upon a stake. (**Galatians 3:13**)
- He himself bore our sins in his own body upon the **stake**, in order, that we might be done with sins and live to righteousness. And by his stripes **you** were healed. (**1 Peter 2:24**)
- This he was really saying to signify what sort of death he was about to die. (**John 12:33**)
- And there they impaled him, and two other men with him, one on this side and one on that, but **Jesus** in the middle. (**John 19:18**)
- The God of Abraham and of Isaac and of Jacob, the God of our **forefathers**, has glorified his Servant, **Jesus**, whom **you**, for **YOUR** part, delivered up and disowned before Pilate's face, when he had decided to release him. (**Acts of Apostles 3:13**)

- Let it be known to all of **you** and to all the people of Israel, that in the name of **Jesus** Christ the Nazarene, whom **you** impaled but whom God **raised** up from the dead, by this one does this man stand here sound in front of **you**. (**Acts of Apostles 4:10**)

- He said; The God of our **forefathers** has chosen you to come to know his will and to see the righteous One and to hear the voice of his mouth. (**Acts of Apostles 22:14**)

- So, my brothers, **you** also were made dead to the Law through the body of the Christ, that **you** might become another's, the one's who was **raised** up from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God. (**Romans 7:4**)

- This wisdom not one of the rulers of this system of things came to know, for if they had known it they would not have impaled the glorious Lord. (**1 Corinthians 2:8**)
