- And, in turn, the seven years of the famine started to come, just as Joseph had said. And the famine developed in all the lands, but in all the land of Egypt there was found bread. (Genesis 41:54)
- So Israel's sons came along with the others who were coming to buy, because the famine existed in the land of Canaan. (Genesis 42:5)
- But seven years of famine will certainly arise after them, and all the plenty in the land of Egypt will certainly be forgotten and the famine will simply consume the land. (Genesis 41:30)
- And the famine was severe in the land. (Genesis 43:1)
- After that they said to Pharaoh; We have come to reside as aliens in the land, because there is no pasturage for the flock that your servants have, for the famine is severe in the land of Canaan. And now let your servants dwell, please, in the land of Goshen. (Genesis 47:4)
- Consequently they said; You have preserved our lives. Let us find favor in the eyes of my lord, and we will become slaves to Pharaoh. (Genesis 47:25)
- And he proceeded to call for a famine upon the land, he broke every rod around which ring-shaped loaves were suspended. (Psalms 105:16)
