- And, in turn, the seven years of the famine started to come, just as Joseph had said. And the famine developed in all the lands, but in all the land of **Egypt** there was found bread. (**Genesis 41:54**)
- So Israel's sons **came** along with the others who were coming to buy, because the famine existed in the land of **Canaan**. (**Genesis 42:5**)
- But seven years of famine will certainly arise after them, and all the plenty in the land of **Egypt** will certainly be forgotten and the famine will simply consume the land. (**Genesis 41:30**)
- And the famine was severe in the land. (**Genesis 43:1**)
- After that they said to Pharaoh; We have come to reside as aliens in the land, because there is no pasturage for the flock that your servants have, for the famine is severe in the land of **Canaan**. And now let your servants dwell, please, in the land of Goshen. (**Genesis 47:4**)
- Consequently they said; You have preserved our lives. Let us find favor in the eyes of my lord, and we will become slaves to Pharaoh. (**Genesis 47:25**)
- And he proceeded to call for a famine upon the land, he broke every rod around which ring-shaped loaves were suspended. (**Psalms 105:16**)
- Is it not an untrue vision that **you** men have visioned, and a lying divination that **you** have said, when saying; The utterance of Yehowah is, when I myself have spoken nothing? (**Ezekiel 13:7**)

- Look! I am about to throw her into a sickbed, and those committing adultery with her into **great tribulation**, unless they repent of her deeds. (**Revelation 2:22**)
- And to him that conquers and observes my deeds down to the end I will give authority over the nations. (**Revelation 2:26**)
