Acts of Apostles 7:8" He also gave him a covenant of circumcision, and thus he became the father of Isaac and circumcised him on the eighth day, and Isaac of Jacob, and Jacob of the twelve family heads.

- This is my covenant that you men will keep, between me and you men, even your seed after you; Every male of yours must get circumcised. (Genesis 17:10)
- And Yehowah turned his attention to Sarah just as he had said, and Yehowah now did to Sarah just as he had spoken. (Genesis 21:1)
- And Abraham proceeded to circumcise Isaac his son when eight days old, just as God had commanded him. (Genesis 21:4)
- And on the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin will be circumcised. (Leviticus 12:3)
- Now when eight days came to the full for circumcising him, his name was also called Jesus, the name called by the angel before he was conceived in the womb. (Luke 2:21)
- And Leah became pregnant and brought a son to birth and then called his name Reuben, for she said; It is because Yehowah has looked upon my wretchedness, in that now my husband will begin to love me. (Genesis 29:32)
- And You must get circumcised in the flesh of Your foreskins, and it must serve as a sign of the covenant between me and You. (Genesis 17:11)
- And Abraham was ninety-nine years old when he had the flesh of his foreskin circumcised. (Genesis 17:24)
- We are twelve brothers, the sons of our father. One is no more, and the youngest is today with our father in the land of Canaan. (Genesis 42:32)

- And Abraham came to be father to Isaac. The sons of Isaac were Esau and Israel. (1 Chronicles 1:34)
- And he received a sign, namely, circumcision, as a seal of the righteousness by the faith he had while in his uncircumcised state, that he might be the father of all those having faith while in uncircumcision, in order for righteousness to be counted to them. (Romans 4:11)
- Who, as such, are Israelites, to whom belong the adoption as sons and the glory and the covenants and the giving of the Law and the sacred service and the promises. (Romans 9:4)
