

WITNESSES - STEPHEN - HE GAVE HIM THE CIRCUMCISION

~ **Witness** ... **Stephen** ... He gave him the circumcision and thus became father to Isaac - Jacob and the twelve family heads' (**Acts of Apostles 7:8**) ^{[12] - References}

Acts of Apostles 7:8 ... He also gave him a covenant of circumcision, and thus he became the father of Isaac and circumcised him on the eighth day, and Isaac of Jacob, and Jacob of the twelve family heads.

- This is my **covenant** that **you** men will keep, between me and **you** men, even your seed after you; Every male of **YOURS** must get **circumcised**. (**Genesis 17:10**)
- And Yehowah turned his attention to Sarah just as he had said, and Yehowah now did to Sarah just as he had spoken. (**Genesis 21:1**)
- And Abraham proceeded to circumcise **Isaac** his son when eight **days** old, just as God had commanded him. (**Genesis 21:4**)
- And on the **eighth day** the flesh of his foreskin will be **circumcised**. (**Leviticus 12:3**)
- Now when eight **days** came to the full for circumcising him, his name was also called Jesus, the name called by the angel before he was conceived in the womb. (**Luke 2:21**)
- And Leah **became** pregnant and brought a son to birth and then called his name Reuben, for she said; It is because Yehowah has looked upon my wretchedness, in that now my husband will begin to love me. (**Genesis 29:32**)
- And **you** must get **circumcised** in the flesh of **YOUR** foreskins, and it must serve as a sign of the **covenant** between me and **you**. (**Genesis 17:11**)
- And Abraham was ninety-nine years old when he had the flesh of his foreskin **circumcised**. (**Genesis 17:24**)
- We are **twelve** brothers, the sons of our **father**. One is no more, and the youngest is today with our **father** in the land of Canaan. (**Genesis 42:32**)

- And Abraham came to be **father** to **Isaac**. The sons of **Isaac** were Esau and Israel. (**1 Chronicles 1:34**)
- And he received a sign, namely, **circumcision**, as a seal of the righteousness by the faith he had while in his uncircumcised state, that he might be the **father** of all those having faith while in uncircumcision, in order for righteousness to be counted to them. (**Romans 4:11**)
- Who, as such, are Israelites, to whom belong the adoption as sons and the glory and the **covenants** and the giving of the Law and the sacred service and the promises. (**Romans 9:4**)
