- Now it came about in the thirtieth year, in the fourth month, on the fifth day of the month, while I was in the midst of the exiled people by the river Chebar, that the **heavens** were **opened** and I began to see visions of God. (**Ezekiel 1:1**)
- After being baptized Jesus immediately came up from the water, and, look! the **heavens** were **opened** up, and he saw descending like a dove **God's** spirit coming upon him. (**Matthew 3:16**)
- He further said to him; Most truly I say to **you** men, **you** will see heaven **opened** up and the angels of God ascending and descending to the **Son** of man. (**John 1:51**)
- I kept on beholding in the visions of the night, and, see there! With the clouds of the **heavens** someone like a son of **man** happened to be coming, and to the Ancient of Days he gained access, and they brought him up close even before that One. (**Daniel 7:13**)
- Who is he that will condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died, yes, rather the one who was raised up from the dead, who is on the **right** hand of God, who also pleads for us. (**Romans 8:34**)
- With which he has operated in the case of the Christ when he raised him up from the dead and seated him at his **right** hand in the heavenly places. (**Ephesians 1:20**)
- If, however, **you** were raised up with the Christ, go on seeking the things above, where the Christ is seated at the **right** hand of God. (**Colossians 3:1**)
- And Elisha began to pray and say; O Yehowah, open his eyes, please, that he may see. Immediately Yehowah **opened** the

attendant's eyes, so that he saw, and, look! The mountainous region was full of horses and war chariots of fire all around Elisha. (**2 Kings 6:17**)

- The utterance of Yehowah to my Lord is; Sit at my **right** hand until I place your enemies as a stool for your feet. (**Psalms 110:1**)
- And beheld heaven **opened** and some sort of vessel descending like a great linen sheet being let down by its four extremities upon the earth. (**Acts of Apostles 10:11**)
