**Acts of Apostles 7:52**.. Which one of the prophets did **YOUR** forefathers not persecute? Yes, they killed those who made announcement in advance concerning the coming of the righteous One, whose betrayers and murderers **YOU** have now become.

- But they were continually making jest at the messengers of the true God and despising his words and mocking at his prophets, until the rage of Yehowah came up against his people, until there was no healing. (**2 Chronicles 36:16**)
- Therefore **YOU** are bearing witness against yourselves that **YOU** are sons of those who murdered the prophets. (**Matthew 23:31**)
- **Yes**, **YOU** disowned that holy and **righteous** one, and **YOU** asked for a man, a murderer, to be freely granted to **YOU**. (**Acts of Apostles 3:14**)
- My little children, I am writing **YOU** these things that **YOU** may not commit a sin. And yet, if anyone does commit a sin, we **have** a helper with the Father, Jesus Christ, a **righteous** one. (**1 John 2:1**)
- Because of restraint and of judgment he was taken away, and who will concern himself even with the details of his generation? For he was severed from the land of the living ones. Because of the transgression of my people he had the stroke. (**Isaiah 53:8**)
- The wicked ones **have** drawn a sword itself and **have** bent their bow, to cause the afflicted and poor one to fall, to slaughter those who are upright in their way. (**Psalms 37:14**)
- A fouled spring and a ruined well is the **righteous** one when staggering before the wicked one. (**Proverbs 25:26**)

- O how the faithful town has **become** a prostitute! She was full of justice, righteousness itself used to lodge in her, but now **murderers**. (**Isaiah 1:21**)
- For **YOUR** own palms **have become** polluted with blood, and **YOUR** fingers with error. **YOUR** own lips **have** spoken falsehood. **YOUR** own tongue kept muttering sheer unrighteousness. (**Isaiah 59:3**)
- To no effect I **have** struck **YOUR** sons. No discipline did they take. **YOUR** sword has devoured **YOUR** prophets, like a lion that is causing ruin. (**Jeremiah 2:30**)
- Because of the sins of her prophets, the errors of her priests, there were in the midst of her those pouring out the blood of **righteous** ones. (**Lamentations 4:13**)
- And they began to rebel against me, and they did not consent to listen to me. The disgusting things of their eyes they did not individually throw away, and the dungy idols of Egypt they did not leave, so that I promised to pour out my rage upon them, in order to bring my anger to its finish upon them in the midst of the land of Egypt. (**Ezekiel 20:8**)
- There are the pronouncing of curses and practicing of deception and murdering and stealing and committing of adultery that **have** broken forth, and acts of bloodshed **have** touched other acts of bloodshed. (**Hosea 4:2**)
- Therefore Law grows numb, and justice never goes forth. Because the wicked one is surrounding the **righteous** one, for that reason justice goes forth crooked. (**Habakkuk 1:4**)
- Rejoice and leap for joy, since **YOUR** reward is great in the heavens, for in that way they persecuted the prophets prior to **YOU**. (**Matthew 5:12**)
- Again he dispatched other slaves, more than the first, but they did the same to these. (**Matthew 21:36**)
- Rejoice in that day and leap, for, look! **YOUR** reward is great in heaven, for those are the same things their **forefathers** used to do to the prophets. (**Luke 6:23**)
- Certainly **YOU** are witnesses of the deeds of **YOUR forefathers** and yet **YOU** give consent to them, because these **killed** the prophets but **YOU** are building their tombs. (**Luke 11:48**)

- But in due season he sent out a slave to the cultivators, that they might give him some of the fruit of the vineyard. The cultivators, however, sent him away empty, after beating him up. (**Luke 20:10**)
- This man, as one delivered up by the determined counsel and foreknowledge of God, **you** fastened to a stake by the hand of Lawless men and did away with. (**Acts of Apostles 2:23**)
- Who **killed** even the Lord Jesus and the prophets and persecuted us. Furthermore, they are not pleasing God, but are against the interests of all men. (**1 Thessalonians 2:15**)
- Betrayers, headstrong, puffed up with pride, lovers of pleasures rather than lovers of God. (**2 Timothy 3:4**)
