- Women ··· Righteous ··· Hannah She kept Samuel with her until he was weaned, then gave him over to Yehowah's service · (1 Samuel 1:22) [10] - References
- 1 Samuel 1:22. As for Hannah, she did not go up, for she had said to her husband; As soon as the boy is weaned, I must bring him, and he must appear before Yehowah and dwell there to time indefinite.

[10] - References

- Three times in the year every male of yours should appear before Yehowah your God in the place that he will choose; in the festival of the unfermented cakes and in the festival of weeks and in the festival of booths, and none should appear before Yehowah empty-handed. (Deuteronomy 16:16)
- Apart from their genealogical enrollment of the males from three years of age upward, of all those coming to the house of Yehowah as a daily matter of course, for their service by their obligations according to their divisions. (2 Chronicles 31:16)
- Whom will one instruct in knowledge, and whom will one make understand what has been heard? Those who have been weaned from the milk, those moved away from the breasts? (Isaiah 28:9)
- And she went on to make a vow and say; O Yehowah of armies, if you will without fail look upon the affliction of your slave girl and actually remember me, and you will not forget your slave girl and actually give to your slave girl a male offspring, I will give him to Yehowah all the days of his life, and no razor will come upon his head. (1 Samuel 1:11)
- Then Elkanah went to Ramah to his house, and as for the boy, he became a minister of Yehowah before Eli the priest. (1 Samuel 2:11)
- All the while the boy Samuel was ministering to Yehowah before Eli, and word from Yehowah had become rare in those days, there was no vision being spread abroad. (1 Samuel 3:1)

- Now the child kept growing and came to be weaned, and Abraham then prepared a big feast on the day of Isaac's being weaned. (Genesis 21:8)
- However, if she at all happens to belong to a husband, and her vow is upon her or the thoughtless promise of her lips that she has bound upon her soul. (Numbers 30:6)
- It must also occur that the one coming out, who comes out of the doors of my house to meet me when I return in peace from the sons of Ammon, must also become Yehowahs, and I must offer that one up as a burnt offering. (Judges 11:31)
- And it came about at the end of two months that she made her return to her father, after which he carried out his vow that he had made toward her. As for her, she never had relations with a man. And it came to be a regulation in Israel. (Judges 11:39)
