1 Samuel 2:1· And Hannah went on to pray and say; My heart does exult in Yehowah, my horn is indeed exalted in Yehowah. My mouth is widened against my enemies, for I do rejoice in the salvation from you.

^[17] - References

- Do not be anxious over anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication along with thanksgiving let **YOUR** petitions be made known to God. (**Philippians 4:6**)

- I will sing to **Yehowah**, for he has dealt rewardingly with me. (**Psalms 13:6**)

- And Mary said; **My** soul magnifies **Yehowah**. (**Luke 1:46**)

- And not only that, but we are also exulting in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation. (**Romans 5:11**)

- **Yehowah** is my crag and my stronghold and the Provider of escape for me. My God is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my shield and my **horn** of **salvation**, my secure height. (**Psalms 18:2**)

- For you are the beauty of their strength, and by your goodwill our **horn** is **exalted**. (**Psalms 89:17**)

- But you will exalt my **horn** like that of a wild bull, I shall moisten myself with fresh oil. (**Psalms 92:10**)

- In order that I may declare all your praiseworthy deeds in the gates of the daughter of Zion, that I may be joyful in your **salvation**. (**Psalms 9:14**)

- As for me, in your loving-kindness I have trusted, let my **heart** be joyful in your **salvation**. (**Psalms 13:5**)

- My God is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my shield and my **horn** of **salvation**, my secure height, and my place for flight, my Savior, from violence you save me. (**2 Samuel 22:3**)

- **You** will not need to fight in this instance. Take **YOUR** position, stand still and see the **salvation** of **Yehowah** in **YOUR** behalf. O Judah and Jerusalem, do not be afraid or be terrified. Tomorrow go out **against** them, and **Yehowah** will be with **you**. (**2 Chronicles 20:17**)
- Then all the men of Judah and Jerusalem returned, with Jehoshaphat at their head, to return to Jerusalem with rejoicing, for **Yehowah** had made them **rejoice** over their **enemies**. (**2 Chronicles 20:27**)
- But let my own soul be joyful in **Yehowah**, let it **exult** in his **salvation**. (**Psalms 35:9**)
- And my faithfulness and my loving-kindness are with him, and in my name his **horn** is **exalted**. (**Psalms 89:24**)
- He has distributed widely, he has given to the poor ones. His righteousness is standing forever. His own **horn** will be **exalted** with glory. (**Psalms 112:9**)
- Without fail I shall **exult** in **Yehowah**. My soul will be joyful in my God. For he has clothed me with the garments of **salvation**, with the sleeveless coat of righteousness he has enwrapped me, like the bridegroom who, in a priestly way, puts on a headdress, and like the bride who decks herself with her ornamental things. (**Isaiah 61:10**)
- Yet, as for me, I will **exult** in **Yehowah** himself, I will be joyful in the God of my **salvation**. (**Habakkuk 3:18**)
