- Women ··· Righteous ··· Hannah Prays to Yehowah exults in him and his blessing (1 Samuel 2:1) [17] References
- 1 Samuel 2:1" And Hannah went on to pray and say; My heart does exult in Yehowah, my horn is indeed exalted in Yehowah. My mouth is widened against my enemies, for I do rejoice in the salvation from you.

[17] - References

- Do not be anxious over anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication along with thanksgiving let YOUR petitions be made known to God. (Philippians 4:6)
- I will sing to Yehowah, for he has dealt rewardingly with me. (Psalms 13:6)
- And Mary said; My soul magnifies Yehowah. (Luke 1:46)
- And not only that, but we are also exulting in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation. (Romans 5:11)
- Yehowah is my crag and my stronghold and the Provider of escape for me. My God is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my shield and my horn of salvation, my secure height. (Psalms 18:2)
- For you are the beauty of their strength, and by your goodwill our horn is exalted. (Psalms 89:17)
- But you will exalt my horn like that of a wild bull, I shall moisten myself with fresh oil. (Psalms 92:10)
- In order that I may declare all your praiseworthy deeds in the gates of the daughter of Zion, that I may be joyful in your salvation. (Psalms 9:14)
- As for me, in your loving-kindness I have trusted, let my heart be joyful in your salvation. (Psalms 13:5)
- My God is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my shield and my horn of salvation, my secure height, and my place for flight, my Savior, from violence you save me. (2 Samuel 22:3)

- You will not need to fight in this instance. Take YOUR position, stand still and see the salvation of Yehowah in YOUR behalf. O Judah and Jerusalem, do not be afraid or be terrified. Tomorrow go out against them, and Yehowah will be with YOU. (2 Chronicles 20:17)
- Then all the men of Judah and Jerusalem returned, with Jehoshaphat at their head, to return to Jerusalem with rejoicing, for Yehowah had made them rejoice over their enemies. (2 Chronicles 20:27)
- But let my own soul be joyful in Yehowah, let it exult in his salvation. (Psalms 35:9)
- And my faithfulness and my loving-kindness are with him, and in my name his horn is exalted. (Psalms 89:24)
- He has distributed widely, he has given to the poor ones. His righteousness is standing forever. His own horn will be exalted with glory. (Psalms 112:9)
- Without fail I shall exult in Yehowah. My soul will be joyful in my God. For he has clothed me with the garments of salvation, with the sleeveless coat of righteousness he has enwrapped me, like the bridegroom who, in a priestly way, puts on a headdress, and like the bride who decks herself with her ornamental things. (Isaiah 61:10)
- Yet, as for me, I will exult in Yehowah himself, I will be joyful in the God of my salvation. (Habakkuk 3:18)
