Acts of Apostles 16:15 Now when she and her household got baptized, she said with entreaty; If **you** men have judged me to be faithful to Yehowah, enter into my house and stay. And she just made us come.

- And he took them along in that hour of the night and bathed their stripes, and, one and all, he and his were **baptized** without delay. (**Acts of Apostles 16:33**)
- But Crispus the presiding officer of the synagogue became a believer in the Lord, and so did all his household. And many of the Corinthians that heard began to believe and be **baptized**. (**Acts of Apostles 18:8**)
- Into whatever city or village **you enter**, search out who in it is deserving, and stay there until **you** leave. (**Matthew 10:11**)
- Share with the holy ones according to their needs. Follow the course of hospitality. (**Romans 12:13**)
- Moreover, let anyone who is being orally taught the word share in all good things with the one who gives such oral teaching. (**Galatians 6:6**)
- Do not forget hospitality, for through it some, unknown to themselves, entertained angels. (**Hebrews 13:2**)
- And he proceeded to say; Please, now, my lords, turn aside, please, into the **house** of **your** servant and stay overnight and **have your** feet washed. Then **you** must get up early and travel on **your** way. To this they **said**; No, but in the public square is where we shall stay overnight. (**Genesis 19:2**)

- However, the old man **said**; May you **have** peace! Just let any lack of yours be upon me. Only do not stay overnight in the public square. (**Judges 19:20**)
- But they used pressure upon him, saying; Stay with us, because it is toward evening and the day has already declined. With that he went in to stay with them. (**Luke 24:29**)
- Then he **said**; Yehowah, if, now, I **have** found favor in your eyes, please do not pass by your servant. (**Genesis 18:3**)
- But he was very insistent with them, so that they turned aside to him and came into his **house**. Then he **made** a feast for them, and he baked unfermented cakes, and they went to eating. (**Genesis 19:3**)
- Take, please, the gift conveying my blessing which was brought to you, because God has favored me and because I **have** everything. And he continued to urge him, so that he took it. (**Genesis 33:11**)
- With that he brought him into his **house** and threw mash to the he-asses. Then they washed their feet and began to eat and drink. (**Judges 19:21**)
- And it came about one day that Elisha went passing along to Shunem, where there was a prominent woman, and she began to constrain him to eat bread. And it came about that as often as he would pass by, he would turn aside there to eat bread. (**2 Kings 4:8**)
