- And the women that were celebrating **kept responding** and saying; Saul **has** struck down his thousands, and David his tens of thousands. (**1 Samuel 18:7**)
- Listen, **you** kings, give ear, **you** high officials; I to **Yehowah**, yes, I, will sing. I shall make melody to **Yehowah**, Israel's God. (**Judges 5:3**)
- As for me, here I am letting the hearts of the Egyptians **become** obstinate, that they may go in after them and that I may get glory for myself by means of Pharaoh and all his military forces, his war chariots and his cavalymen. (**Exodus 14:17**)
- Now I do know that **Yehowah** is greater than all the **other** gods by reason of this affair in which they acted presumptuously against them. (**Exodus 18:11**)
- Moses at once stretched his hand out over the sea, and the sea began to come back to its normal condition at the approaching of morning. All the while the Egyptians were fleeing from encountering it, but **Yehowah** shook the Egyptians off into the midst of the sea. (**Exodus 14:27**)
- At that time Moses and the sons of Israel proceeded to sing this song to **Yehowah** and to say the following; Let me sing to **Yehowah**, for he **has become highly exalted** the **horse** and its **rider** he **has pitched** into the sea. (**Exodus 15:1**)
- And it came about that at their coming in, when David returned from striking the Philistines down, the women began coming out from

all the cities of Israel with song and dances to meet Saul the king, with tambourines, with rejoicing and with lutes. (**1 Samuel 18:6**)

- And they began to respond by praising and giving thanks to **Yehowah**, for he is good, for his loving-kindness toward Israel is to time indefinite. As for all the people, they shouted with a loud shout in praising **Yehowah** over the laying of the foundation of the house of **Yehowah**. (**Ezra 3:11**)

- Apart from their **men** slaves and their slave girls, these being seven thousand three hundred and thirty-seven, and they had two hundred and forty-five male singers and female singers. (**Nehemiah 7:67**)
