1 Kings 10:9... May Yehowah your God come to be blessed, who has taken delight in you by putting you upon the throne of Israel, because Yehowah loves Israel to time indefinite, so that he appointed you as king to render judicial decision and righteousness.

- And it came about that as soon as Hiram heard the words of Solomon, he began to rejoice greatly, and he went on to say; Blessed is **Yehowah** today in that he **has** given David a wise son over this numerous people! (1 Kings 5:7)
- Blessed be **Yehowah God**, Israel's **God**, who alone is doing wonderful works. (Psalms 72:18)
- And he proceeded to bring me out into a roomy place, he was rescuing me, because he had found **delight** in me. (Psalms 18:19)
- Saying; I, even I, have installed my **king** upon Zion, my holy mountain. (Psalms 2:6)
- But it was because of Yehowah's loving **YOU**, and because of his keeping the sworn statement that he had sworn to **YOUR** forefathers, that **Yehowah** brought **you** out with a strong hand, that he might redeem you from the house of slaves, from the hand of Pharaoh the **king** of Egypt. (Deuteronomy 7:8)
- And you proceeded to constitute your people **Israel** as your people to time **indefinite**, and you yourself, O **Yehowah**, became their **God**. (1 Chronicles 17:22)
- At that Hiram the **king** of Tyre said the word in writing and sent it to Solomon; Because **Yehowah** loved his people he **has** constituted you **king** over them. (2 Chronicles 2:11)

- But King Solomon will be **blessed**, and the **throne** of David itself will prove to be firmly established before **Yehowah** forever. (**1 Kings 2:45**)
- May **Yehowah** your **God** come to be **blessed**, who **has taken delight** in you by **putting** you upon his **throne** as **king** for **Yehowah** your **God**, because your **God** loved **Israel**, to make it stand to time **indefinite**, so that he put you over them as **king** to execute **judicial decision** and righteousness. (**2 Chronicles 9:8**)
- The queen of the south will be raised up in the judgment with the men of this generation and will condemn them, because she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon, but, look! Something more than Solomon is here. (**Luke 11:31**)
- Nathanael answered him; Rabbi, you are the Son of **God**, you are King of Israel. (**John 1:49**)
- And David kept reigning over all **Israel**, and David was continually rendering **judicial decision** and **righteousness** for all his people. (**2 Samuel 8:15**)
- To the abundance of the princely rule and to peace there will be no end, upon the **throne** of David and upon his kingdom in order to establish it firmly and to sustain it by means of justice and by means of **righteousness**, from now on and to time **indefinite**. The very zeal of **Yehowah** of armies will do this. (**Isaiah 9:7**)
- The **God** of **Israel** said, to me the Rock of **Israel** spoke, when one ruling over mankind is righteous, ruling in the fear of **God**. (**2 Samuel 23:3**)
- May he plead the cause of your people with **righteousness** and of your afflicted ones with **judicial decision**. (**Psalms 72:2**)
- And with **righteousness** he must judge the lowly ones, and with uprightness he must give reproof in behalf of the meek ones of the earth. And he must strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the spirit of his lips he will put the wicked one to death. (**Isaiah 11:4**)
- Will you continue reigning because you are competing by use of cedar? As for your father, did he not eat and drink and execute justice and **righteousness**? In that case it went well with him. (**Jeremiah 22:15**)

- And David came to know that **Yehowah** had firmly established him as **king** over **Israel** and that he had exalted his kingdom for the sake of his people **Israel**. (**2 Samuel 5:12**)
- And now, as **Yehowah** is living who **has** firmly established me and keeps me seated upon the **throne** of David my father and who made a house for me just as he **has** spoken, today Adonijah will be put to death. (**1 Kings 2:24**)
- And David came to know that **Yehowah** had firmly established him as **king** over **Israel**, for his kingship was highly exalted on account of his people **Israel**. (**1 Chronicles 14:2**)
