## RAHAB - PEOPLE ARE DISHEARTENED BY THE FIRGHT OF YOU

- Women ··· Righteous ··· Rahab I know that Yehowah will certainly give you the land, the people are disheartened by the fright of your people · (Joshua 2:9) [21] - References
- Yehowah will certainly give you the land, and that the fright of you has fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land have become disheartened because of you.

[21] - References

- Because all the land at which you are looking, to you and to your seed I am going to give it until time indefinite. (Genesis 13:15)
- On that day Yehowah concluded with Abram a covenant, saying; To your seed I will give this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates. (Genesis 15:18)
- And I am proceeding to go down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land to a land good and spacious, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the locality of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites. (Exodus 3:8)
- And I shall send the fright of me ahead of you, and I shall certainly throw into confusion all the people among whom you come, and I shall indeed give the back of the neck of all your enemies to you. (Exodus 23:27)
- This day I shall start to put the dread of you and the fear of you before the peoples beneath all the heavens, who will hear the report about you, and they will indeed be agitated and have pains like those of childbirth because of you. (Deuteronomy 2:25)
- No man will make a firm stand against You. The dread of You and the fear of You Yehowah Your God will put before the face of all the land on which You will tread, just as he has promised You. (Deuteronomy 11:25)

- At that time the sheiks of Edom will indeed be disturbed, As for the despots of Moab, trembling will take hold on them. All the inhabitants of Canaan will indeed be disheartened. (Exodus 15:15)
- And it came about that as soon as all the kings of the Amorites, who were on the side of the Jordan to the west, and all the kings of the Canaanites, who were by the sea, heard that Yehowah had dried up the waters of the Jordan from before the sons of Israel until they had passed over, then their hearts began to melt, and there proved to be no spiritedness in them anymore because of the sons of Israel. (Joshua 5:1)
- The wicked one himself will see and certainly become vexed. He will grind his very teeth and actually melt away. The desire of the wicked ones will perish. (Psalms 112:10)
- After that they pulled away, and the terror of God came to be upon the cities that were round about them, so that they did not chase after the sons of Jacob. (Genesis 35:5)
- Fright and dread will fall upon them. Because of the greatness of your arm they will be motionless like a stone, Until your people pass by, O Yehowah, until the people whom you have produced pass by. (Exodus 15:16)
- The great provings that your eyes saw, and the signs and the miracles and the strong hand and the outstretched arm with which Yehowah your God brought you out. That is the way Yehowah your God will do to all the peoples before whom you are afraid. (Deuteronomy 7:19)
- And Yehowah your God will also send the feeling of dejection upon them, until those perish who were let remain and who were concealing themselves from before you. (Deuteronomy 7:20)
- And they went on to say to Joshua; Yehowah has given all the land into our hand. Consequently all the inhabitants of the land have also grown disheartened because of us. (Joshua 2:24)
- Now Jericho was tightly shut up because of the sons of Israel, no one going out and no one entering. (Joshua 6:1)
- So I sent the feeling of dejection ahead of YOU, and it gradually drove them out before YOU, two kings of the Amorites, not with your sword and not with your bow. (Joshua 24:12)

- And even the valiant man whose heart is as the heart of the lion will himself surely soften in weakness, for all Israel is aware that your father is a mighty man and so, too, are the valiant men that are with him. (2 Samuel 17:10)
- And David's fame began to go out into all the lands, and Yehowah himself put the dread of him upon all the nations. (1 Chronicles 14:17)
- At that time our mouth came to be filled with laughter, and our tongue with a joyful cry. At that time they proceeded to say among the nations; Yehowah has done a great thing in what he has done with them. (Psalms 126:2)
- And they will talk about the strength of your own fear-inspiring things, and as for your greatness, I will declare it. (Psalms 145:6)
- They will lick up dust like the serpents, like reptiles of the earth they will come in agitation out of their bulwarks. To Yehowah our God they will come quivering, and they will be afraid of you. (Micah 7:17)
