

RAHAB - PEOPLE ARE DISHEARTENED BY THE FRIGHT OF YOU

~ **Women ... Righteous ... Rahab** - I know that Yehowah will certainly give you the land, the people are disheartened by the fright of your people' (**Joshua 2:9**) ^[21] - References

Joshua 2:9 And she went on to say to the men; I do know that Yehowah will certainly give **you** the land, and that the fright of **you** has fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land have become disheartened because of **you**.

^[21] - References

- Because all the **land** at which you are looking, to you and to your seed I am going to **give** it until time indefinite. (**Genesis 13:15**)
- On that day **Yehowah** concluded with Abram a covenant, saying; To your seed I **will give** this **land**, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates. (**Genesis 15:18**)
- And I am proceeding to go down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that **land** to a **land** good and spacious, to a **land** flowing with milk and honey, to the locality of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites. (**Exodus 3:8**)
- And I shall send the **fright** of me ahead of you, and I shall **certainly** throw into confusion all the people among whom you come, and I shall indeed **give** the back of the neck of all your enemies to you. (**Exodus 23:27**)
- This day I shall start to put the dread of you and the fear of you before the peoples beneath all the heavens, who **will** hear the report about you, and they **will** indeed be agitated and **have** pains like those of childbirth because of you. (**Deuteronomy 2:25**)
- No man **will** make a firm stand against **you**. The dread of **you** and the fear of **you Yehowah YOUR God will** put before the face of all the **land** on which **you will** tread, just as he **has** promised **you**. (**Deuteronomy 11:25**)

- At that time the sheiks of Edom **will** indeed be disturbed, As for the despots of Moab, trembling **will** take hold on them. All the **inhabitants** of Canaan **will** indeed be **disheartened**. (**Exodus 15:15**)
- And it came about that as soon as all the kings of the Amorites, who were on the side of the Jordan to the west, and all the kings of the Canaanites, who were by the sea, heard that **Yehowah** had dried up the waters of the Jordan from before the sons of Israel until they had passed over, then their hearts began to melt, and there proved to be no spiritedness in them anymore because of the sons of Israel. (**Joshua 5:1**)
- The wicked one himself **will** see and **certainly become** vexed. He **will** grind his very teeth and actually melt away. The desire of the wicked ones **will** perish. (**Psalms 112:10**)
- After that they pulled away, and the terror of God came to be upon the cities that were round about them, so that they did not chase after the sons of Jacob. (**Genesis 35:5**)
- Fright and dread **will** fall upon them. Because of the greatness of your arm they **will** be motionless like a stone, Until your people pass by, O **Yehowah**, until the people whom you **have** produced pass by. (**Exodus 15:16**)
- The great provings that your eyes saw, and the signs and the miracles and the strong hand and the outstretched arm with which **Yehowah** your God brought you out. That is the way **Yehowah** your God **will** do to all the peoples before whom you are afraid. (**Deuteronomy 7:19**)
- And **Yehowah** your God **will** also send the feeling of dejection upon them, until those perish who were let remain and who were concealing themselves from before you. (**Deuteronomy 7:20**)
- And they went on to **say** to Joshua; **Yehowah** **has** given all the **land** into our hand. Consequently all the **inhabitants** of the **land** **have** also grown **disheartened** because of us. (**Joshua 2:24**)
- Now Jericho was tightly shut up because of the sons of Israel, no one going out and no one entering. (**Joshua 6:1**)
- So I sent the feeling of dejection ahead of **you**, and it gradually drove them out before **you**, two kings of the Amorites, not with your sword and not with your bow. (**Joshua 24:12**)

- And even the valiant man whose heart is as the heart of the lion **will** himself surely soften in weakness, for all Israel is aware that your father is a mighty man and so, too, are the valiant **men** that are with him. (**2 Samuel 17:10**)
- And David's fame began to go out into all the **lands**, and **Yehowah** himself put the dread of him upon all the nations. (**1 Chronicles 14:17**)
- At that time our mouth came to be filled with laughter, and our tongue with a joyful cry. At that time they proceeded to **say** among the nations; Yehowah **has** done a great thing in what he **has** done with them. (**Psalms 126:2**)
- And they **will** talk about the strength of your own fear-inspiring things, and as for your greatness, I **will** declare it. (**Psalms 145:6**)
- They **will** lick up dust like the serpents, like reptiles of the earth they **will** come in agitation out of their bulwarks. To **Yehowah** our God they **will** come quivering, and they **will** be afraid of you. (**Micah 7:17**)
