## **RAHAB - WE HAVE HEARD OF YEHOWAH'S GREAT ACTS**

Women ··· Righteous ··· Rahab - We have heard of Yehowah's great acts in Egypt, what you did to the Amorites, Sihon and Og · (Joshua 2:10) [21] - References

Joshua 2:10... For we have heard how Yehowah dried up the waters of the Red Sea from before you when you came out of Egypt, and what you did to the two kings of the Amorites who were on the other side of the Jordan, namely, Sihon and Og, whom you devoted to destruction.

[21] - References

- Moses now stretched his hand out over the sea, and Yehowah began making the sea go back by a strong east wind all night long and converting the sea basin into dry ground, and the waters were being split apart. (Exodus 14:21)
- Peoples must hear, they will be agitated, Birth pangs must take hold on the inhabitants of Philistia. (Exodus 15:14)
- When Yehowah YOUR God dried up the waters of the Jordan from before them until they had passed over, just as Yehowah YOUR God had done to the Red Sea when he dried it up from before us until we had passed over. (Joshua 4:23)
- At this they said to him; It is from a very distant land that your servants have come in regard to the name of Yehowah your God, because we have heard of his fame and of all that he did in Egypt. (Joshua 9:9)
- Israel now sent messengers to Sihon the king of the Amorites,
  saying; (Numbers 21:21)
- At that Israel struck him with the edge of the sword and took possession of his land from the Arnon to the Jabbok, near the sons of Ammon, because Jazer is the border of the sons of Ammon. (Numbers 21:24)
- Yehowah now said to Moses; Do not be afraid of him, for into your hand I shall certainly give him and all his people and his land, and you must do to him just as you did to Sihon, the king of the Amorites, who used to dwell in Heshbon. (Numbers 21:34)

- Accordingly Yehowah our God gave into our hand also Og the king of Bashan and all his people, and we kept striking him until he had no survivor remaining. (Deuteronomy 3:3)
- And of all that he did to the two kings of the Amorites who were on the other side of the Jordan, namely, Sihon the king of Heshbon and Og the king of Bashan, who was in Ashtaroth. (Joshua 9:10)
- Even Sihon the king of the Amorites and Og the king of Bashan and all the kingdoms of Canaan. (Psalms 135:11)
- No devoted person who might be devoted to destruction from among mankind may be redeemed. He should be put to death without fail. (Leviticus 27:29)
- But, in fact, for this cause I have kept you in existence, for the sake of showing you my power and in order to have my name declared in all the earth. (Exodus 9:16)
- So I shall indeed let Pharaoh's heart become obstinate, and he will certainly chase after them and I shall get glory for myself by means of Pharaoh and all his military forces, and the Egyptians will certainly know that I am Yehowah. Accordingly they did just that. (Exodus 14:4)
- Now Jethro the priest of Midian, Moses' father-in-law, got to hear about all that God had done for Moses and for Israel his people, how Yehowah had brought Israel out of Egypt. (Exodus 18:1)
- And they will be bound to tell it to the inhabitants of this land. They have heard that you are Yehowah in among this people, who has appeared face to face. You are Yehowah, and your cloud is standing over them, and you are going before them in the pillar of cloud by day and in the pillar of fire by night. (Numbers 14:14)
- Yehowah is known by the judgment that he has executed. By the activity of his own hands the wicked one has been ensnared. (Psalms 9:16)
- Accordingly he rebuked the Red Sea, and it was gradually dried up, and he went walking them through the watery deep as through the wilderness. (Psalms 106:9)
- What was the matter with you, O sea, that you took to flight, O
  Jordan, that you began to turn back? (Psalms 114:5)
- To the One severing the Red Sea into parts, for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (Psalms 136:13)

- Even Sihon the king of the Amorites, for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (Psalms 136:19)
- And I went acting for the sake of my own name that it might not be profaned before the eyes of the nations in among whom they were, because I had made myself known to them before their eyes on bringing them forth from the land of Egypt. (Ezekiel 20:9)
