

JEZEBEL - BROUGHT FORTH FALSE WITNESSES AGAINST NABOTH

~ **Women ... Unrighteous ... Jezebel** - Make two good for nothing fellows bear witness against Naboth, saying; you have cursed God and the king, bring him out and stone him' (**1 Kings 21:10**) ^[26] - References

1 Kings 21:10 And **MAKE** two men, good-for-nothing fellows, sit in front of him, and let them bear witness against him, saying; You have cursed God and the king! And **BRING** him out and stone him that he may die.

^[26] - References

- At the mouth of **two** witnesses or of three witnesses the one dying should be put to death. He will not be put to death at the mouth of one **witness**. (**Deuteronomy 17:6**)
- Now the sons of Eli were **good-for-nothing men**, they did not acknowledge Yehowah. (**1 Samuel 2:12**)
- Now there happened to be there a **good-for-nothing** man, whose name was Sheba, the son of Bichri a Benjaminite, and he proceeded to blow the horn and say; We **have** no share in David, and we **have** no inheritance in the son of Jesse. Every one to his gods, O Israel! (**2 Samuel 20:1**)
- You must not testify falsely as a **witness against** your fellowman. (**Exodus 20:16**)
- Neither must you testify to a falsehood **against** your fellowman. (**Deuteronomy 5:20**)
- A false **witness** that launches forth lies, and anyone sending forth contentions among brothers. (**Proverbs 6:19**)
- Do not become a **witness against** your fellowman without grounds. Then you would **have** to be foolish with your lips. (**Proverbs 24:28**)
- As for the unprincipled man, his instruments are bad, he himself has given counsel for acts of loose conduct, to wreck the afflicted ones with false **sayings**, even when someone poor speaks what is right. (**Isaiah 32:7**)

- And they brought forward false witnesses, who said; This man does not stop speaking things **against** this holy place and **against** the Law. (**Acts of Apostles 6:13**)
- You must not call down evil upon **God** nor curse a chieftain among your people. (**Exodus 22:28**)
- So the abuser of Yehowah's name should be put to death without fail. The entire assembly should without fail pelt him with **stones**. The alien resident the same as the native should be put to death for his abusing the Name. (**Leviticus 24:16**)
- Then the High Priest ripped his outer garments, **saying**; He has blasphemed! What further need do we **have** of witnesses? See! Now **you have** heard the blasphemy. (**Matthew 26:65**)
- And Paul said; Brothers, I did not know he was High Priest. For it is written: **You** must not speak injuriously of a ruler of your people. (**Acts of Apostles 23:5**)
- So the abuser of Yehowah's name should be put to death without fail. The entire assembly should without fail pelt him with **stones**. The alien resident the same as the native should be put to death for his abusing the Name. (**Leviticus 24:16**)
- The Jews answered him; We are stoning you, not for a fine work, but for blasphemy, even because you, although being a man, make yourself a god. (**John 10:33**)
- And after throwing him outside the city, they began casting **stones** at him. And the witnesses laid down their outer garments at the feet of a young man called Saul. (**Acts of Apostles 7:58**)
- Good-for-nothing **men have** gone **out** from your midst that they may try to turn away the inhabitants of their city, **saying**; Let us go and serve other gods, whom you **have** not known. (**Deuteronomy 13:13**)
- No single **witness** should rise up **against** a man respecting any error or any sin, in the case of any sin that he may commit. At the mouth of **two** witnesses or at the mouth of three witnesses the matter should stand good. (**Deuteronomy 19:15**)
- Then **two** of the **men, good-for-nothing fellows**, came in and sat down in **front** of him, and the **good-for-nothing men** began to **bear witness against** him, that is, Naboth, in **front** of the people, **saying**; Naboth has **cursed God** and the king! After that they brought him **out**

to the outskirts of the city and stoned him with **stones**, so that he died. (**1 Kings 21:13**)

- And Elisha was sitting in his own house, and the older **men** were sitting with him, when he sent a man from before him. Before the messenger could come in to him, he himself said to the older **men**; Have **you** seen how this son of a murderer has sent to take off my head? See to it. As soon as the messenger comes, close the door, and **you** must press him back with the door. Is there not the sound of the feet of his lord behind him? (**2 Kings 6:32**)

- And idle **men**, **good-for-nothing fellows**, kept collecting themselves together by him. Finally they proved superior to Rehoboam the son of Solomon, when Rehoboam himself happened to be young and fainthearted, and he did not hold his own **against** them. (**2 Chronicles 13:7**)

- Will the throne causing adversities be allied with you while it is framing trouble by decree? (**Psalms 94:20**)

- A **good-for-nothing witness** derides justice, and the very mouth of wicked people swallows down what is hurtful. (**Proverbs 19:28**)

- And I **have** further seen under the sun the place of justice where there was wickedness and the place of righteousness where wickedness was. (**Ecclesiastes 3:16**)

- Then they started to accuse him, **saying**; This man we found subverting our nation and forbidding the paying of taxes to Caesar and **saying** he himself is Christ a king. (**Luke 23:2**)

- Then they secretly induced **men** to say; We **have** heard him speaking blasphemous **sayings against** Moses and God. (**Acts of Apostles 6:11**)
