WORD OR LOGOS - UNDESERVED KINDNESS AND TRUTH THROUGH HIM

- ~ The Word … Undeserved Kindness … Through Christ The Law was given through Moses but the undeserved kindness and the truth came to be through Christ (John 1:17) [28] References
- Because the Law was given through Moses, the undeserved kindness and the truth came to be through Jesus Christ.

[28] - References

- Now as soon as he had finished speaking with him on Mount Sinai he proceeded to give Moses two tablets of the Testimony, tablets of stone written on by God's finger. (Exodus 31:18)
- Now this is the Law that Moses set before the sons of Israel. (Deuteronomy 4:44)
- Moses gave you the Law, did he not? But not one of you obeys the Law. Why are you seeking to kill me? (John 7:19)
- And it is as a free gift that they are being declared righteous by his undeserved kindness through the release by the ransom paid by Christ Jesus. (Romans 3:24)
- For sin must not be master over YOU, seeing that YOU are not under Law but under undeserved kindness. (Romans 6:14)
- And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free. (John 8:32)
- Jesus said to him; I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (John 14:6)
- Therefore Pilate said to him; Well, then, are you a king? Jesus answered; You yourself are saying that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone that is on the side of the truth listens to my voice. (John 18:37)
- For no matter how many the promises of God are, they have become Yes by means of him. Therefore also through him is the Amen said to God for glory through us. (2 Corinthians 1:20)

- These are the regulations and the judicial decisions and the Laws that Yehowah set between himself and the sons of Israel in Mount Sinai by means of Moses. (Leviticus 26:46)
- These are the commandments that Yehowah gave Moses as commands to the sons of Israel in Mount Sinai. (Leviticus 27:34)
- Moses laid as a command upon us a Law, a possession of the congregation of Jacob. (Deuteronomy 33:4)
- He will send from heaven and save me. He will certainly confuse the one snapping at me. God will send his loving-kindness and his trueness. (Psalms 57:3)
- God raised this One up on the third day and granted him to become manifest. (Acts of Apostles 10:40)
- On the contrary, we trust to get saved through the undeserved kindness of the Lord Jesus in the same way as those people also. (Acts of Apostles 15:11)
- Yes, God's righteousness through the faith in Jesus Christ, for all those having faith. For there is no distinction. (Romans 3:22)
- To what end? That, just as sin ruled as king with death, likewise also undeserved kindness might rule as king through righteousness with everlasting life in view through Jesus Christ our Lord. (Romans 5:21)
- I always thank God for you in view of the undeserved kindness of God given to you in Christ Jesus. (1 Corinthians 1:4)
- Consequently let us keep the festival, not with old leaven, neither with leaven of badness and wickedness, but with unfermented cakes of sincerity and truth. (1 Corinthians 5:8)
- Thanks be to God for his indescribable free gift. (2 Corinthians 9:15)
- I do not shove aside the undeserved kindness of God, for if righteousness is through Law, Christ actually died for nothing. (Galatians 2:21)
- Why, then, the Law? It was added to make transgressions manifest, until the seed should arrive to whom the promise had been made, and it was transmitted through angels by the hand of a mediator. (Galatians 3:19)

- May You have undeserved kindness and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (Ephesians 1:2)
- Made us alive together with the Christ, even when we were dead in trespasses, by undeserved kindness you have been saved. (Ephesians 2:5)
- You, therefore, my child, keep on acquiring power in the undeserved kindness that is in connection with Christ Jesus. (2 Timothy 2:1)
- For the undeserved kindness of God which brings salvation to all sorts of men has been manifested. (Titus 2:11)
- But have to do only with foods and drinks and various baptisms. They were legal requirements pertaining to the flesh and were imposed until the appointed time to set things straight. (Hebrews 9:10)
- Do not be carried away with various and strange teachings, for it is fine for the heart to be given firmness by undeserved kindness, not by eatables, by which those who occupy themselves with them have not been benefited. (Hebrews 13:9)
