

Galatians 1:11~ For I put you on notice, brothers, that the Good News, which was declared by me as Good News, is not something human.

- 1· Paul now declares, that the Good News, that he declares to others, is not of human origin, but came from God to him through divine inspiration, for he did not learn the Good News from other men, like most other men do.

[Question] How did Paul himself come to know the Good News of God, and how is this different from how most men receive it?

- 2· Indeed, that is why we also thank God incessantly, because when you received God's word, which you heard from us, you accepted it, not as the word of men, but, just as it truthfully is, as the word of God, which is also at work in you believers. (**1 Thessalonians 2:13**)

[Question] How properly did the Thessalonians view the witness Paul spoke to them?

- 3· If we have sown spiritual things to you, is it something great if we shall reap things for the flesh from you? (**1 Corinthians 9:11**)

[Question] What was Paul entitled to receive from anointed congregations, due to his spiritual work among them?

- 4· Now I make known to you, **brothers**, the Good News which I **declared** to you, which you also received, in which you also stand. (**1 Corinthians 15:1**)

[Question] What were the Corinthian Christians standing firm in?
