

Galatians 1:12~ For neither did I receive it from man, nor was I taught it, except through revelation¹ by Jesus Christ.

Footnote: Literally; uncovering, disclosure Greek, a·po·ka·ly'pse·os

- 1· Paul was an opposer of Christianity in its early stages, and a powerful appearance to him by Christ, changed his life course, and also was the means, by which the Good News of Christ was disclosed to him personally.

[Question] How did Paul come to know the Good News of God originally?

- 2· Now to him who can make you firm in accord with the Good News I declare, and the preaching of **Jesus Christ**, according to the **revelation** of the sacred secret, which has been kept in silence for long-lasting times (**Romans 16:25**)

[Question] What revelation of a sacred secret of God is the Good News?

- 3· But I went up as a result of a **revelation**. And I laid before them the Good News which I am preaching among the nations, privately, however, before those who were outstanding men, for fear that somehow, I was running, or had run in vain. (**Galatians 2:2**)

[Question] What did Paul do after many years of successful preaching, when he went to Jerusalem to reassure himself, that he was preaching correctly?

- 4· That by way of a **revelation** the sacred secret was made known to me, just as I wrote previously in brief. (**Ephesians 3:3**)

[Question] How was the sacred secret of the Good News made known to Paul personally?

- 5· He said; The God of our forefathers has chosen you to come to know his will, and to see the righteous One and to hear the voice of his mouth. (**Acts of Apostles 22:14**)

[Question] What was it God's will for anointed Christians to see and hear?

- 6· Nevertheless, rise and stand on your feet. For to this end I

have made myself visible to you, in order to choose you as an attendant and a witness both of things you have seen and things I shall make you see respecting me. (Acts of Apostles 26:16)

[Question] Why did Jesus Christ make himself visible to Paul, when he appeared to him on the way to Damascus?

- 7· **But at this time, brothers, if I should come speaking to you in tongues, what good would I do you unless I spoke to you either with a **revelation**, or with knowledge, or with a prophecy, or with a teaching? (1 Corinthians 14:6)**

[Question] What spiritual gifts did Paul use to upbuild the congregations?

- 8· **For I handed on to you, among the first things, that which I also received, that **Christ** died for our sins according to the Scriptures. (1 Corinthians 15:3)**

[Question] What is one of the first things concerning the Good News of God?

- 9· **Paul, an apostle, neither from men nor **through a man**, but **through Jesus Christ** and God the Father, who raised him up from the dead. (Galatians 1:1)**

[Question] Who sent Paul forth to be an apostle to the nations?
