Galatians 1:12~ For neither did I receive it from man, nor was I taught it, except through revelation by Jesus Christ.

1 Paul was an opposer of Christianity in its early stages, and a powerful appearance to him by Christ, changed his life course, and also was the means, by which the Good News of Christ was disclosed to him personally.

[Question] How did Paul come to know the Good News of God originally?

2. Now to him who can make you firm in accord with the Good News I declare, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the sacred secret, which has been kept in silence for long-lasting times (Romans 16:25)

[Question] What revelation of a sacred secret of God is the Good News?

3. But I went up as a result of a revelation. And I laid before them the Good News which I am preaching among the nations, privately, however, before those who were outstanding men, for fear that somehow, I was running, or had run in vain. (Galatians 2:2)

[Question] What did Paul do after many years of successful preaching, when he went to Jerusalem to reassure himself, that he was preaching correctly?

4. That by way of a revelation the sacred secret was made known to me, just as I wrote previously in brief. (Ephesians 3:3)

[Question] How was the sacred secret of the Good News made known to Paul personally?

5. He said; The God of our forefathers has chosen you to come to know his will, and to see the righteous One and to hear the voice of his mouth. (Acts of Apostles 22:14)

[Question] What was it God's will for anointed Christians to see and hear?

6. Nevertheless, rise and stand on your feet. For to this end I

have made myself visible to you, in order to choose you as an attendant and a witness both of things you have seen and things I shall make you see respecting me. (Acts of Apostles 26:16)

[Question] Why did Jesus Christ make himself visible to Paul, when he appeared to him on the way to Damascus?

7. But at this time, brothers, if I should come speaking to you in tongues, what good would I do you unless I spoke to you either with a revelation, or with knowledge, or with a prophecy, or with a teaching? (1 Corinthians 14:6)

[Question] What spiritual gifts did Paul use to upbuild the congregations?

8. For I handed on to you, among the first things, that which I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures. (1 Corinthians 15:3)

[Question] What is one of the first things concerning the Good News of God?

9 Paul, an apostle, neither from men nor through a man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised him up from the dead. (Galatians 1:1)

[Question] Who sent Paul forth to be an apostle to the nations?
