Galatians 1:15~ But when God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me through his undeserved kindness, thought good.

Footnote: Literally, having defined me off out of the cavity of my mother

1. Yet it was God himself who called Paul to his service through undeserved kindness, for in no way was Paul worthy of being selected as an apostle of Christ. He had tried to kill, and did in fact share in the killing of numerous Christians.

[Question] Who called Paul to his service, for was Paul in any way deserving of his undeserved kindness?

[Question] What, like unfaithful Cain before him, had he done?

2 Paul, called to be an apostle of Jesus Christ through God's will, and Sosthenes our brother (1 Corinthians 1:1)

[Question] Through whose will, was Paul called to be an apostle?

3. To the end that you should go on walking worthily of God, who is calling you to his kingdom and glory. (1
Thessalonians 2:12)

[Question] Who calls all other anointed ones to their fine calling, and how then should they walk before their God?

4. In this way, therefore, at the present season also, a remnant has turned up, according to a choosing due to undeserved kindness. (Romans 11:5)

[Question] How did a remnant of faithful anointed sons turn up in the First Century C.E. from among the Jews?

5. I became a minister of this, according to the free gift of the undeserved kindness of God, that was given me, according to the way his power operates. (Ephesians 3:7)

[Question] How did Paul then, become a minister of the Good News?

6. Upon you I have been thrown from the womb, from the belly of my mother, you have been my God. (Psalms 22:10)

[Question] How did the Psalmist feel about his service to God?

7. For he will be great before Yehowah. But he must drink no wine and strong drink at all, and he will be filled with Holy

Spirit right from his mother's womb. (Luke 1:15)

[Question] How would John the Baptist serve Yehowah God throughout his life?

8. He said; The God of our forefathers has chosen you to come to know his will, and to see the righteous One, and to hear the voice of his mouth. (Acts of Apostles 22:14)

[Question] What work had the apostle Paul been chosen by God to do?

9 Paul, a slave of Jesus Christ and called to be an apostle, separated to God's Good News. (Romans 1:1)

[Question] What work was Paul called to by God, and what was he separated to, from among the Jewish nation?

10" However, I am writing you the more outspokenly on some points, as if reminding you again, because of the undeserved kindness given to me from God. (Romans 15:15)

[Question] Why did Paul keep on reminding his spiritual brothers of God's fine counsel?
