Galatians 1:19~ But I saw no one else of the apostles, only James the brother of the Lord.

1. While there, he did not see any of the other apostles, only James the brother of the Lord, who later wrote the Letter of James.

[Question] Who alone then, did Paul see, while there on his first visit to Jerusalem?

2. But he motioned to them with his hand to be silent and told them in detail how Yehowah brought him out of the prison, and he said; Report these things to James and the brothers. With that he went out and journeyed to another place. (Acts of Apostles 12:17)

[Question] What things did Peter relate about his escape from prison?

3. Is this not the carpenter's son? Is not his mother called Mary, and his brothers James and Joseph and Simon and Judas? (Matthew 13:55)

[Question] Who were also members of Jesus Christ's family?

4' We have authority to lead about a sister as a wife, even as the rest of the apostles and the Lord's brothers and Cephas, do we not? (1 Corinthians 9:5)

[Question] What authority do all of the Apostle of Jesus Christ have?

5' While he was yet speaking to the crowds, look! His mother and brothers took up a position outside seeking to speak to him. (Matthew 12:46)

[Question] Who came up to see Jesus Christ during his earthly ministry?

6. And his sisters, are they not all with us? Where, then, did this man get all these things? (Matthew 13:56)

[Question] Did Jesus Christ also have sisters?

7' This is the carpenter the son of Mary and the brother of James and Joseph and Judas and Simon, is it not? And his sisters are here with us, are they not? So they began to stumble at him. (Mark 6:3)

[Question] What were the names of the brothers of Jesus Christ?

[Question] Did he also have more than one sister?

[Question] So then, how many children did Mary have at the very least?

8. After this he and his mother and brothers and his disciples went down to Capernaum, but they did not stay there many days. (John 2:12)

[Question] Who accompanied Jesus Christ, when he went down to Capernaum?

9. Therefore his brothers said to him; Pass on over from here and go into Judea, in order, that your disciples also may behold the works you do. (John 7:3)

**[Question]** How did his brothers counsel him to perform his ministry?

10" With one accord all these were persisting in prayer, together with some women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers. (Acts of Apostles 1:14)

[Question] Who were among those gathered together at Pentecost?

11. But on the following day Paul went in with us to James, and all the older men were present. (Acts of Apostles 21:18)

[Question] Who did Paul visit while in Jerusalem?

12. James, a slave of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes that are scattered about. Greetings! (James 1:1)

[Question] How did James, Jesus' brother, view himself before his Lord?
