2. Give my greetings to every holy one in union with Christ Jesus. The brothers who are with me send you their greetings. (Philippians 4:21)

[Question] How did he likewise send his greetings to the Philippians?

3. Now concerning the collection, that is for the holy ones, just as I gave orders to the congregations of Galatia, do that way also yourselves. (1 Corinthians 16:1)

[Question] What kind giving had he also started within the congregation in Galatia?

4. The sons of Japheth were Gomer and Magog and Madai and Javan and Tubal and Meshech and Tiras. (Genesis 10:2)

[Question] From what son of Noah did these peoples stem from?

5. For Demas has forsaken me, because he loved the present system of things, and he has gone to Thessalonica, Crescens to Galatia, Titus to Dalmatia. (2 Timothy 4:10)

[Question] What brother had Paul sent to Galatia to minister there?

6. A revelation by Jesus Christ, which God gave him, to show his slaves the things that must shortly take place. And he sent forth his angel and presented it in signs through him to his slave John. (Revelation 1:1)
