

Galatians 1:22~ But I was unknown by face to the congregations of Judea that were in union with Christ;

- 1· He was then at that time unknown to the congregations of anointed Christians in Jerusalem and in all of Judea.

[Question] When Paul first visited Jerusalem, to whom was he unknown by face?

- 2· In order, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in **union** with me, and I am in **union** with you, that they also may be in **union** with us, in order, that the world may believe, that you sent me forth. (**John 17:21**)

[Question] What unity of mind and spirit did Jesus Christ pray for his congregation to have with him and God?

- 3· Greet Andronicus and Junias my relatives and my fellow captives, who are men of note among the apostles and who have been in **union** with **Christ**, longer than I have. (**Romans 16:7**)

[Question] Who of Paul's relatives were also in the truth, and had been Christians, before he became one?

- 4· But it is due to him, that you are in **union** with **Christ** Jesus, who has become to us wisdom from God, also righteousness and sanctification and release by ransom. (**1 Corinthians 1:30**)

[Question] What has Jesus Christ become to anointed Christians?

- 5· For you became imitators, brothers, of the **congregations** of God, that are in **Judea**, in **union** with **Christ** Jesus, because you also began suffering at the hands of your own countrymen the same things as they also are suffering at the hands of the Jews. (**1 Thessalonians 2:14**)

[Question] What did the congregation in Judea suffer through, that also later came upon others in far-flung regions?
