Galatians 1:3~ May you have undeserved kindness and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1. Paul then wishes for them to abound in God's undeserved kindness, and his peace, through the Holy Spirit within them, which comes through Jesus Christ from the father.

[Question] What does Paul now wish for his anointed brothers in Galatia to have in full measure, and how does this come to them?

2. May you have undeserved kindness and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Corinthians 1:3)

[Question] What does Paul now ask God to extend to them?

3. And all those who will walk orderly by this rule of conduct, upon them be peace and mercy, even upon the Israel of God. (Galatians 6:16)

[Question] Upon whom will peace and mercy be extended by God?

4. There will be with us undeserved kindness, mercy and peace from God the Father and from Jesus Christ the Son of the Father, with truth and love. (2 John 1:3)

[Question] What fine things come to anointed Christians through the Holy Spirit dwelling within then from God?

5. To all those who are in Rome as God's beloved ones, called to be holy ones; May you have undeserved kindness and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (Romans 1:7)

[Question] What does Paul ask God to extend to them?

6. To the holy ones and faithful brothers in union with Christ at Colossae. May you have undeserved kindness and peace, from God our Father. (Colossians 1:2)

[Question] What does Paul ask God to extend to those ones there in Colossae?
