

Galatians 1:4~ He gave himself for our sins that he might deliver us from the present wicked system of things¹ according to the will of our God and Father.

Footnote: Or, order of things Greek, *ai·o·nos*; Latin, *sae'cu·lo*; J17, 18, 22(Hebrew), *ha·`oh·lam'*; the order of things

- 1· Now referring to Jesus Christ, he shows, that Christ gave of himself in behalf of our sins, so as to deliver anointed Christians from the wicked powers of the present wicked system of things under Satan the Devil, for this is God's will for them.

[Question] Why did Christ offer himself to anointed Christians in death?

- 2· Who gave himself for us that he might deliver us from every sort of lawlessness, and cleanse for himself a people peculiarly his own, zealous for fine works. (**Titus 2:14**)

[Question] What does Christ deliver anointed Christians from?

[Question] What does this then, free us to become before him?

- 3· And he is a propitiatory sacrifice for our sins, yet not for ours only but also for the whole world's. (**1 John 2:2**)

[Question] Who also is Christ a sacrifice for, besides anointed Christians?

- 4· If you were part of the world, the world would be fond of what is its own. Now because you are no part of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, on this account the world hates you. (**John 15:19**)

[Question] Why does the world hate anointed Christians?

- 5· And quit being fashioned after this system of things, but be transformed by making your mind over, that you may prove to yourselves the good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (**Romans 12:2**)

[Question] What should we no longer be fashioned after?

[Question] What must we prove to ourselves through reasonableness?

- 6· Say to them; As I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah; I take delight, not in the death

of the **wicked** one, but in that someone **wicked** turns back from his way and actually keeps living. Turn back, turn back from your bad ways, for why is it that you should die, O house of Israel? (**Ezekiel 33:11**)

[Question] What does Yehowah God, the giver of life to all persons, delight in seeing?

- 7· Whose **will** is, that all sorts of men should be saved, and come to an accurate knowledge of truth. (**1 Timothy 2:4**)

[Question] What is it God's will for all mankind to attain to, and to know about him?

- 8· He now went presenting the offering of the people, and took the goat of the sin offering, that was for the people, and slaughtered it, and made an offering for sin with it, as with the first. (**Leviticus 9:15**)

[Question] What offering was made yearly in behalf of all the people of Israel?

- 9· And with many other words he bore thorough witness and kept exhorting them, saying; Get saved from this crooked generation. (**Acts of Apostles 2:40**)

[Question] What did Peter counsel the men gathered before him, to get saved from?

- 10· For even the Christ did not please himself, but just as it is written: The reproaches of those who were reproaching you have fallen upon me. (**Romans 15:3**)

[Question] What reproaches against God, came to also fall upon Christ, his foremost representative?

- 11· Husbands, continue loving your wives, just as the Christ also loved the congregation and delivered up himself for it. (**Ephesians 5:25**)

[Question] How should anointed Christian men, treat their wives?

- 12· By the said; Will, we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all time. (**Hebrews 10:10**)

[Question] By whose will have anointed Christians been sanctified?
