Galatians 1:6~ I marvel that you are being so quickly removed from the One who called you with Christ's undeserved kindness over to another sort of Good News.

1 Paul marvels, that they are being quickly removed from Yehowah God, who called them through the undeserved kindness of Christ, over to another sort of Good News, something different, than what Paul had earlier taught them.

[Question] What does Paul now hear, that they are being called away from?

2. But Christ was faithful as a Son over the house of that One. We are the house of that One, if we make fast our hold on our freeness of speech, and our boasting over the hope firm to the end. (Hebrews 3:6)

[Question] What are anointed Christians, and who built this house?
[Question] How can we make fast our hold on everlasting life, and truly gain this wonderful hope?

3. May you have undeserved kindness and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Corinthians 1:2)

[Question] What does Paul ask God to extend to faithful anointed ones?

4. For, as it is, if someone comes and preaches a Jesus other than the one we preached, or you receive a spirit other than what you received, or Good News other than what you accepted, you easily put up with him. (2 Corinthians 11:4)

[Question] What did those in Corinth readily accept?

5' You were running well. Who hindered you from keeping on obeying the truth? (Galatians 5:7)

[Question] What does Paul ask of the Galatians, since they were running well in the race for life?

6. And when he had passed some time there, he departed and went from place to place through the country of Galatia and Phrygia, strengthening all the disciples. (Acts of Apostles 18:23)

[Question] Where did Paul go to after leaving Antioch?

7. This sort of persuasion is not from the One calling you. (Galatians 5:8)

[Question] Where was the thinking that was leading them away from the Good News of God, coming from?

8. Just as I encouraged you to stay in Ephesus, when I was about to go my way into Macedonia, so I do now, that you might command certain ones, not to teach different doctrine. (1 Timothy 1:3)

[Question] What did Paul command Timothy to not allow to be taught within the congregations?

9. Beloved ones, though I was making every effort to write you about the salvation we hold in common, I found it necessary to write you to exhort you to put up a hard fight for the faith, that was once for all time delivered to the holy ones. (Jude 1:3)

[Question] What did Jude write them, to put up a hard fight for?
