

**Galatians 1:9~** As we have said above, I also now say again; Whoever it is that is declaring to you as Good News, something beyond what you accepted, let him be accursed.

- 1· Now just to emphasize his point, he says again, that no one can change the Good News of God. Anyone trying to do so, is to be accursed of God.

**[Question]** What did Paul say should happen to anyone, changing the Good News of God?

- 2· Every word that I am commanding you is **what** you should be careful to do. You must not add to it nor take away from it. (**Deuteronomy 12:32**)

**[Question]** What instruction did Moses give the Israelites, regarding his counsel from Yehowah God?

- 3· Add nothing to his words, that he may not reprove you, and that you may not have to be proved a liar. (**Proverbs 30:6**)

**[Question]** Why were they to add nothing, to the words given them through Yehowah God?

- 4· But we have renounced the underhanded things of which to be ashamed, not walking with cunning, neither adulterating the word of God, but by making the truth manifest, recommending ourselves to every human conscience in the sight of God. (**2 Corinthians 4:2**)

**[Question]** What underhanded ways of dealing have anointed Christians renounced?
