

**Galatians 2:10~** Only we should keep the poor in mind. This very thing I have also earnestly endeavored to do.

- 1· They did however ask, that as Paul went preaching, that he would keep the poor in mind, and bring the Good News to them without stressing them unduly. This Paul always did try to do, as he had done with the Corinthian congregation.

**[Question]** What did those in Jerusalem encourage Paul to keep in mind, when preaching among the nations?

- 2· For you should generously open your hand to him and by all means lend him on pledge as much as he needs, which he is in want of. (**Deuteronomy 15:8**)

**[Question]** What did the Law Covenant specify, as the way to treat a poor brother?

- 3· Now concerning the collection, that is for the holy ones, just as I gave orders to the congregations of Galatia, do that way also yourselves. (**1 Corinthians 16:1**)

**[Question]** What collections did Paul start among those in Galatia?

- 4· So those of the disciples determined, each of them according as anyone could afford it, to send a relief ministration to the brothers dwelling in Judea. (**Acts of Apostles 11:29**)

**[Question]** What did the disciples decide to do, as each could afford it, for their poorer brothers in Judea?

- 5· According to the days on which the Jews had rested from their enemies and the month that was changed for them from grief to rejoicing, and from mourning to a good day, to hold them as days of banqueting and rejoicing and sending of portions to one another, and of gifts to the poor people. (**Esther 9:22**)

**[Question]** What earlier has the Jews done to celebrate their deliverance through Mordecai?
