

**Galatians 2:13~** The rest of the Jews also joined him in putting on this pretense,<sup>1</sup> so that even Barnabas was led along with them in their pretense.

**Footnote:** Literally, hypocrisy Greek, *hy-po-kri'sei*

- 1· Then others there, who were Jews, also followed after what amounted to a bad example, that Peter was setting for others, out of respect for him. Even Barnabus went along with them in this pretense.

**[Question]** What persons also followed along with Peter in his wrong pretense, of separating himself from Gentiles?

- 2· But the wisdom from above is first of all chaste, then peaceable, reasonable, ready to obey, full of mercy and good fruits, **not making partial distinctions**, not hypocritical. (**James 3:17**)

**[Question]** What is the wisdom from above made up of?

**[Question]** Does the wisdom from above, allow for partiality or hypocrisy?

- 3· At this there occurred a sharp burst of anger, so that they separated from each other, and **Barnabas** took Mark along and sailed away to Cyprus. (**Acts of Apostles 15:39**)

**[Question]** What disagreement did Paul and Barnabus have, concerning Mark?
