Galatians 2:15~ We who are Jews by nature, and not sinners from the nations.

1 Paul then argues, that we, himself included, along with Peter, who are Jews by nature, and not sinners of the nations, for the Jews viewed all Gentiles as sinners, for they had no means of atonement with God before Christ came.

[Question] How did all Jews, including Peter and Paul before they became Christians, view Gentiles, and why so?

2. In answer they said to him; Our father is Abraham. Jesus said to them; If you are Abraham's children, do the works of Abraham. (John 8:39)

[Question] What did Jesus call for the Jews to practice, if they were truly children of Abraham?

3. They also, if they do not remain in their lack of faith, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again. (Romans 11:23)

[Question] What could Yehowah God do with the Jews, if they left their lack of faith?

4. That you were at that particular time without Christ, alienated from the state of Israel and strangers to the covenants of the promise, and you had no hope, and were without God in the world. (Ephesians 2:12)

[Question] What was the state of Gentile anointed Christians before becoming Christians?

[Question] Did they then, have any means of atonement for their sins before God?
