

Galatians 2:19~ As for me, through Law, I died toward Law, that I might become alive toward God.

- 1· Paul then, had died regarding Law, that he might become alive toward God in a new way, by striving through his love of the Holy Spirit, to actually fulfill the Law, by living by all its principles and tenets based upon heartfelt obedience.

[Question] What did Paul die towards, so as to come to life before God in spirit?

[Question] Now, on what basis, will Paul obey the principles of the Law Covenant?

- 2· In fact, I was once **alive** apart from **Law**, but when the commandment arrived, sin came to life again, but I **died**. (**Romans 7:9**)

[Question] What happened to Paul, when he first learned the Law Covenant?

- 3· Likewise also you. Reckon yourselves to be dead indeed with reference to sin, but living with reference to **God** by Christ Jesus. (**Romans 6:11**)

[Question] What should anointed Christians be dead to, and living to?

- 4· How much more will the blood of the Christ, who through an everlasting spirit offered himself without blemish to **God**, cleanse our consciences from dead works, that we may render sacred service to the living **God**? (**Hebrews 9:14**)

[Question] What will the blood of Christ cleanse our consciences from, and to what purpose?

- 5· So, my brothers, you also were made dead to the Law through the body of the Christ, that you **might become** another's, the one's, who was raised up from the dead, that we should bear fruit to **God**. (**Romans 7:4**)

[Question] What were anointed Christians made dead to, through the body of the Christ, and why?

- 6· But now we have been discharged from the Law, because we have **died** to that by which we were being held fast,

that we **might** be slaves in a new sense, by the spirit, and not in the old sense, by the written code. (**Romans 7:6**)

[Question] Why have anointed Christians been discharged from the Law Covenant?

[Question] How now, will they need to become slaves to God and Christ?

- 7· For both if we live, we live to Yehowah, and if we die, we die to Yehowah. Therefore both if we live and if we die, we belong to Yehowah. (**Romans 14:8**)

[Question] Who do anointed Christians belong to, through any further outcome?
