

**Galatians 2:21~ I do not shove aside the undeserved kindness of God, for if righteousness is through Law, Christ actually died for nothing.**

- 1· To go back to old Jewish practices would be to shove aside this faith in Christ, and push away God's great undeserved kindness. For if righteousness came through the Law Covenant, then Christ died for nothing.

**[Question]** What would it be doing to go back to those old Jewish practices?

**[Question]** What would be the case if true righteousness came through the Law Covenant?

- 2· Because the Law was given **through** Moses, the **undeserved kindness** and the truth, came to be **through** Jesus **Christ**. (**John 1:17**)

**[Question]** What did Moses bring forth as a mediator, and what does Christ bring forth?

- 3· On the other hand, to the man that does not work, but puts faith in him who declares the ungodly one righteous, his faith is counted as **righteousness**. (**Romans 4:5**)

**[Question]** What then, is to be counted as righteousness before God?

- 4· Is the Law, therefore, against the promises of **God**? May that never happen! For if a **Law** had been given that was able to give life, **righteousness** would **actually** have been by means of **Law**. (**Galatians 3:21**)

**[Question]** Is the Law Covenant against the promises of God?

**[Question]** What would have come to mankind through the Law, if it had been possible?

- 5· If, then, perfection were really **through** the Levitical priesthood, for with it as a feature the people were given the Law, what further need would there be for another priest to arise according to the manner of Melchizedek, and not said to be according to the manner of Aaron? (**Hebrews 7:11**)

**[Question]** What question does Paul ask about the need for a better priesthood, than the Levitical priesthood?

- 6· Owing to no works in **righteousness** that we had performed, but according to his mercy, he saved us **through** the bath, that brought us to life and **through** the making of us new by Holy Spirit. (**Titus 3:5**)

**[Question]** According to what did Yehowah God save us?

**[Question]** How did he cleanse the fleshly body through what?

**[Question]** How did he cleanse the spirit, through what?

- 7· But Israel, although pursuing a **Law** of **righteousness**, did not attain to the **Law**. (**Romans 9:31**)

**[Question]** What was Israel pursuing, but did they actually attain to it?
