

Galatians 2:3~ Nevertheless, not even Titus, who was with me, was compelled to be circumcised, although he was a Greek.

- 1· However, not even Titus, who was a Greek, was compelled to get circumcised.

[Question] What was the Greek man Titus, not compelled to become?

- 2· I got no relief in my spirit on account of not finding **Titus** my brother, but I said good-bye to them, and departed for Macedonia. (**2 Corinthians 2:13**)

[Question] What caused Paul, to get no relief in his spirit?

- 3· Paul expressed the desire for this man to go out with him, and he took him and **circumcised** him, because of the Jews that were in those places, for one and all knew that his father was a **Greek**. (**Acts of Apostles 16:3**)

[Question] Why did Paul circumcise Timothy?

- 4· To those without Law I became as without Law, although I am not without Law toward God, but under Law toward Christ, that I might gain those without Law. (**1 Corinthians 9:21**)

[Question] Why did Paul do such things, though not under Law?

- 5· For as regards Christ Jesus neither is circumcision of any value nor is uncircumcision, but faith operating through love is. (**Galatians 5:6**)

[Question] What is more important, than circumcision or uncircumcision?

- 6· All those who want to make a pleasing appearance in the flesh, are the ones that try to compel you to get **circumcised**, only that they may not be persecuted for the torture stake of the Christ, Jesus. (**Galatians 6:12**)

[Question] What were ones trying to make them get to be acceptable to God?

[Question] What did Paul then see, as the reason for them wanting to do this?
