Galatians 2:3~ Nevertheless, not even Titus, who was with me, was compelled to be circumcised, although he was a Greek.

1. However, not even Titus, who was a Greek, was compelled to get circumcised.

[Question] What was the Greek man Titus, not compelled to become?

2. I got no relief in my spirit on account of not finding Titus my brother, but I said good-bye to them, and departed for Macedonia. (2 Corinthians 2:13)

[Question] What caused Paul, to get no relief in his spirit?

3. Paul expressed the desire for this man to go out with him, and he took him and circumcised him, because of the Jews that were in those places, for one and all knew that his father was a Greek. (Acts of Apostles 16:3)

[Question] Why did Paul circumcise Timothy?

4. To those without Law I became as without Law, although I am not without Law toward God, but under Law toward Christ, that I might gain those without Law. (1 Corinthians 9:21)

[Question] Why did Paul do such things, though not under Law?

5. For as regards Christ Jesus neither is circumcision of any value nor is uncircumcision, but faith operating through love is. (Galatians 5:6)

[Question] What is more important, than circumcision or uncircumcision?

6. All those who want to make a pleasing appearance in the flesh, are the ones that try to compel you to get circumcised, only that they may not be persecuted for the torture stake of the Christ, Jesus. (Galatians 6:12)

[Question] What were ones trying to make them get to be acceptable to God?

[Question] What did Paul then see, as the reason for them wanting to do this?
